BRITISH ARTILLERY IN ACTION, SOMEWHERE IN N AFRICA

Heavy artillery pieces under camouflaged nets are fired. British officers giving order to fire. British soldiers at a sandbag embankment. Other soldiers come through and walk over the embankment. Another line of the men walking on the desert. Brief shot of some of the men putting bayonets on rifles. Shots through concertina wire of the British soldiers with bayoneted rifles moving past L to R. Unit of British troops charging over the desert, then falling to the ground.

Pan Shot of the men lying on the ground while in the bg explosions from shell fire.

Small group of the men charging fwd, then looking out on the desert as explosions take place.

LS, of trucks. Trains in bg.
