Seq: four platoons of Moroccan Spahis of a mechanized cavalry unit form before the residence of Col Remy in Hornsea to celebrate Bastille Day with the raising of the French tricolor.

CU, as the flag is raised.

CU, Col Remy saluting. Spahis march, assemble at side of road, present arms.

Seq: At the hq of the 2nd French Armored Div at Dalton-Holme, the residence of CG Jacques Philippe Leclerc, guard inspection is held. Gen Leclerc accompanied by his aide inspects the guard.

Half-tracks and M-8 howitzer motor carriages move by on the field in this problem.

The name Lorraine on a vehicle. Men move a 57mm gun into place and get it ready for firing. The commander gets into jeep and the half-tracks and M-8s follow in a column.

VS of the motorized column on the move.

Seq: the French Armored Marine Regt (these men are not similar to our marines, but sailors who have become soldiers.) The men prepare their vehicles for inspection. The men put a steel plate on an armored vehicle. Gen Leclerc and other officers including Col Dics, inspect the Marine Regt.
