SUBJECT: New GSA Regional Headquarters

General Services Administration has announced the establishment of a new regional office headquarters in an effort to respond to the rapid growth in the Washington, D.C. - Philadelphia area.

-The National Capital Area region will be responsible for carrying out GSA's functions in the District of Columbia, the counties of Montgomery and Prince Georges in Maryland, and the city of Alexandria and the counties of Arlington, Fairfax, Loudoun, and Prince William in Virginia.

-The GSA Region 3 headquarters in Philadelphia will be responsible for carrying out GSA's functions in the States of Pennsylvania, Virginia, West Virginia, Maryland, and Delaware, with the exception of those areas included in the National Capital Area region. Clarence A. Lee, Jr., has been designated as Regional Administrator, Region 3.

Region 3 (Philadelphia) will become operational as expeditiously as possible. October 1, 1979, has been set as the initial startup date.
