Mr. Joseph F. Finnegan, Director, Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service, announced this afternoon that he, Assistant Director Clyde M. Mills, and Special Assistant Robert H. Moore have arranged to meet with Mr. David J. McDonald, President of the United Steelworkers, and his associates in Pittsburgh Thursday morning, July 5, and with Mr. John A. Stephens, spokesman for the Steel Industry negotiators, and his associates Thursday afternoon.

These meetings will be exploratory in nature and for the purpose of discussing the real differences between the union and the industry representatives, and when and in what manner the Service can be most beneficial in assisting the parties to an agreement.
