Internment Camp No. 91

Recklinghausen, Germany

3 May 1945

Seq: Officer and enlisted man of CIC unit drive thru streets of town in a jeep and stop at a house. The two men walk to the door; a man answers and shows his identification. The soldiers place the man under arrest and transport him to the internment camp.

CU, soldiers on guard at gate above which hangs the sign "No 91 Internment Camp".  
Ints, arrested German civilian, accused of brutality to prisoners, is searched and questioned by an enlisted man of CIC Unit.

VS, arrested suspect at work in camp carrying boxes of dirt, sawing wood, and repairing buildings.

Ints, CUs, interrogation of suspect.

Ints, Polish girl examines photographs at CIC HQ and picks out picture of former labor boss at concentration camp who had beaten prisoners.
