ELS, troops of 7th Cav, 1st Cav Div, wading across Naktong River
(caption says recrossing Naktong River after patrol.)

LS, huge cloud of smoke rising from ammo dump blown up by our troops.
Korean hut burning.

LS, smoke pouring up from village, result of exploding ammo dump.
MS, thatch roof of hut, smoking.

ABOARD THE CRUISER "USS TOLEDO" AT SEA

16 Aug 1950

LS and RV, sailors scrubbing deck. LS, destroyer No 729 at sea.

MLS from Toledo, destroyer pulling up alongside for mail transfer.

Shot, mail cylinder being pulled across between the two ships.

Aboard "Toledo" as cylinder is taken aboard.

The destroyer "729" underway, r to l. MS, stuffing canvas bag into cylinder.

MS, three 8" guns on the "Toledo" being fired at target on N Korean shore.

ELS, very hazy, supposedly showing the smoke rising from a shell hit, barely seen.

MS, CU as three 8" guns are fired.

MS and CU, Rear Adm J M Higgins on deck during firing.

CU, Lt j g C E Day looking through telescope.

MCU, seaman apprentice, R G Barry, drinking coffee.
LS from rear of ship, gun mount and super-structure, with sailors in chow line in fg.
MS RV, seaman J Muzquez looking out from deck.
HAS, bow of ship, showing sailors cleaning 8" gun in fg.

18 Aug 1950

CU, seaman T V Hope braiding rope on life ring.
MCU, seaman W P Batterson sending message with flags.
Seaman R W Morgan, ship's bugler sounding over ship's comm set.
HMS, men standing by at 40mm twin AAA guns.
Boatswain Mate J Blevins sounds bosun's pipe over ship's comm set.
MCU RV, Aerographer B B Anderson inking pen on hygrothermograph.
CU, Rear Adm J M Higgins sitting on flag bridge. A seaman brings him a clipboard.
MCU and CU, Capt of "Toledo", R F Stout looking out to sea from bridge.
MSs, fireman V F Bettencourt and R J Herrington securing radio antenna.
MS, men sitting on deck reading.

19 Aug 1950

MLS, Destroyer "USS Mansfield" about to pull alongside the "Toledo" for refueling.

Vs, fuel lines being passed between the ships in choppy sea.

August 24, 1950

Negro officer leaves Korean ship in seat suspended on cable between two vessels.

Scenes as the officer is pulled aboard "Toledo".

CU, Sgt George Kim, interpreter, 34th Inf Regt, speaking to Korean boat through electric megaphone.

MLS, So Korean patrol boat pulling away.

August 26, 1950

LS, of heavy cruiser USS Helena at sea. MLS, superstructure, "Toledo".

MS, empty shell containers on deck of "Toledo".
