PART II

1. Personnel. Two Officers and 34 enlisted personnel completed overseas tours and rotated to CONUS. Twenty-two members of this Company made use of R&R Quotas to Okinawa, Hawaii, Bangkok, Hong Kong, Tokyo, Manila, Taipei, Singapore, and Kuala Lumpur. Four enlisted members extended overseas tours with four men departing on Special 30 Day Leave in connection with tour extensions. Two members departed on 30 day leave as a result of re-enlisting.

2. Combat Operations & Training. Members of this company participated in "Operation ELLIOTT" from 2 July 1967 to 6 July 1967. The command post was harrassed on nine separate occasions by small arms fire resulting in no Marine casualties. The outpost, formed by a Marine squad in Duong Son (2) has been formally deactivated. All bunkers and fighting holes were torn down and filled in. All equipment has been returned to the Command Post. Listening post, ambushes, and patrols continue. Indoctrinations was conducted for all personnel of the rank E-4 and above on proper handling and care and cleaning of the M-16 rifle on 25 July 1967.

### 3. Logistics.

a. Supply. During the month of July this organization submitted 464 requisitions of which 10 were priority 02, 38 a priority 05, 241 a priority 12, and the remaining 175 a priority 17. Quantities of material on hand was sufficient to satisfy 42 per cent of the recurring demands received. Shortages are on valid priority requisitions.

#### b. Motor Transport.

(1) Motor Transport vehicles suffered no accidents, damage or pilferage during the month of July.

(2) Motor Transport vehicles traveled a total of 18,419 miles during the month of July.

(3) One vehicle was deadlined during the month of July, due to the lack of parts.
