PART II
NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. Personnel. Four Officers and thirty Enlisted members completed overseas tours and rotated to CONUS. Twenty-four members of this company made use of R&R quotas to Hawaii, Hong Kong, Taipei, Tokyo, Penang, Bangkok, Kuala Lumpur, Singapore, Okinawa, and Manila. One Officer and seven Enlisted members extended their overseas tours during November. Thirty-six Enlisted replacements were joined into this company during the month of November.

2. Combat Operations & Training. Ten members of this company received instructions and fam-fired the fifty caliber machinegun. All members of this company have received instruction, fam-fired, and established their zeroes with the M-16 Rifle. New personnel are receiving this instruction as they are joined into the company.

3. Logistics.

a. Supply. During the month of November, this organization submitted a total of 626 requisitions of which 28 were a priority 02, 58 a priority 05, 211 a priority 12 and the remaining 329 a priority 17. Quantities on hand were sufficient to satisfy 48% of the recurring demands received. Shortages are on valid priority requisitions.

b. Motor Transport.

(1) Motor Vehicles suffered no accidents, damage or pilferage during the month of November.

(2) Motor Vehicles traveled a total of 8,230 miles during November.

(3) Ten Vehicles were deadlined for a total of 172 days during November due to the lack of parts.
