Narrative Summary

1. Personnel. Three Officers and twenty enlisted members completed overseas tours and rotated to CONUS. Three Officers and 22 replacements were joined into this command during June. Twenty-six enlisted members made use of R&R quotas to Okinawa, Taipei, Tokyo, Hong Kong, Manila, Kuala Lumpur, Australia, Singapore, Bangkok and Hawaii. Four enlisted members extended their overseas tour during the month of June.

2. Combat Operations and Training.

During the month of June, classes were held on the handling and setting up of trip flares, claymore mines, and map reading.

During the month of June, HqCo, administrative rear, Phu Bai, encountered no enemy contact during the entire month.

3. Logistics.

a. Supply. During the month of June, this Organization submitted 202 requisitions of which 101 were a priority 02, 9 were a priority 03, 88 were a priority 12, and 4 were a priority 17. Quantities on hand were sufficient to satisfy 47 per cent of the recurring demand received. Shortages are on a call priority requisition.
