SECTION B  
NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. Personnel: Twenty-seven enlisted members and five officers completed their overseas tours and rotated to CONUS during the month of July. Five officers and twenty-four enlisted members were jointed on the rolls of Headquarters Company during the month. Six officers and sixteen enlisted members made use of R&R quotas to Manila, Okinawa, Singapore, Tokyo, Bangkok, Hong Kong, Hawaii, and Taipei.

2. Combat Operations and Training Classes: Classes were conducted during the month on the M-60 Machine Gun techniques of fire, map and compass reading, operation of the PRC-25 and PRC-88, prevention and treatment of heat casualties, FO procedures for artillery and mortars, Career Planning lecture, and Safety Operation of the M-16 rifle and Starlight Scope.
