9. Mission Assigned

a. First Battalion, First Marines occupies and controls assigned sector of TAOR, defends MLR in assigned TAOR, provides security for installation on Hill 327 (AT 971737), provides security force in coordination with Regional Forces for bridge at (AT 946699) and conducts unilateral search and destroy operations in assigned TAOR. The Battalion conducts aggressive combat/reconnaissance patrolling throughout the assigned TAOR, prepared to conduct combined and coordinated operations with RVNAF within or beyond the boundaries of assigned TAOR. The battalion designates one company as regimental reserve to be committed only on authority of Regimental Headquarters.

b. The battalion conducts all operations in such a manner as to gain the loyalty and cooperation of the people and create conditions which permit the people to pursue their normal routine in peace and security.

10. Background. To accomplish the assigned mission the battalion TAOR has been divided into company sectors with each rifle company conducting aggressive patrolling, village sweeps and numerous ambushes in their assigned sector. The companies defend their portion of the MLR by employing observation posts, listening posts, road blocks, checkpoints and through occupation of prepared positions in critical areas. During the period 31 November to 18 December 1965 the battalion furnished one squad for DANANG harbor security.

2. Administration.

a. Personnel Accounting.

(1) Since the last report, the difficulty encountered in the initial phases of the rotation of personnel to CONUS has been alleviated by the timely arrival of orders from higher headquarters.

(2) Since the last report, the difficulty encountered with replacements arriving without complete record books has been alleviated considerably. Those arriving from CONUS have had their records in their possession. However, personnel reporting to this command from other units within the 3d Marine Division continue to arrive without orders and/or record books. In some cases, this causes considerable delay in joining the personnel concerned, in order to indicate the correct on roll strength of the command.

b. Awards.

for the battalion to furnish organic transportation in order to pick up supplies and service the companies. The normal amount of time required to service the entire battalion is two days. The reason is the physical separation of the companies, the extra rifle company presently under the operational control of this command, and the condition of the roads. In both instances, the quantity of supplies has been adequate to service the entire command.

g. Temporary Warrant Officer, Second Lieutenant Program. There were two applications submitted this month by Staff Non-Commissioned Officers of this command requesting selection for either warrant officer or second lieutenant.

(3) One Special Court Martial conducted in October is being reviewed by the Judge Advocate General.

(4) Investigations. There were three investigations completed during the month, three more are presently being conducted.

(5) Inquiries. Two inquiries were conducted in accordance with per 13265 of the MARCORPERSMAN. One resulted in the discharge of the subject Marine for reasons of unsuitability. The other resulted in the retention of the subject.

3. Intelligence

a. Enemy Situation at the beginning of the period. Intelligence reports revealed that VC morale has improved but supply problems, especially the procurement of rice, remain critical. Informers reported that VC were planning raids on rice growing areas within and adjacent to the MLR because many rice caches were captured and destroyed by ARVN and USMC units in past months. One significant report revealed that the USMC units at Hill #41 (AT934664) and Hill #22 (AT954668) were hindering the VC supply line from the low lands to the mountainous area in the west. No VC Main Force attacks were made at the beginning of the month despite continued reports of VC Main Force companies and battalions preparing to attack the area of Hill #41 and Hill #22. All VC activities at the beginning of the month were limited to probing actions and sniper fire.

b. Enemy initiated incidents during the period.

(1) The enemy initiated thirty-four incidents within the TAOR of 1st Battalion, 1st Marines. Sixteen of these were during daylight hours (0600-1800); the remainder were during the hours of darkness (1800-0600). The majority of the incidents reported were probing actions and harassing sniper fire.

(2) 121305H December 1965 a lone VC attacked a Bravo Co. observation post killing 1 Marine and capturing 2 M-14 rifles. This is the only incident of an actual VC assault on a USMC position within the TAOR during the month of December.

(3) 262355H December 1965 an unknown number of VC delivered intense small arms fire and several rifle grenades against Alfa Co. security squad at the pontoon bridge (AT947699). No friendly casualties were suffered and the VC withdrew when the position could not be penetrated.

(4) This month, agent reports confirmed the presence of a Main Force VC Battalion in the southern sector of the TAOR. This unit has been tentatively identified as the DOC LAP Battalion. On three occasions unconfirmed reports were received locating a PAVN Battalion in the mountainous area, west of the TAOR. The reports have not been substantiated by the capture of PAVN soldiers or PAVN ralliers.

d. Significant trends noted during the period. Nineteen reports of battalion sized units were received during the month of December. Of these, three were reported to be PAVN units and the remainder Viet Cong Main Force. Although reports indicate a build up in the southern portion of the TAOR, the reported units did not initiate any offensive activity. Viet Cong prisoners taken by ARVN units revealed that the Main Force VC units bolstered guerrilla morale by providing heavy weapons support to guerrilla attacks; Main Force units did not participate in the assault phase of the attacks. The establishment of the new MLR has seriously impeded VC movement in the populated areas of the TAOR. The protection provided by this new deployment has increased our ability to protect the local populace thereby making them more at ease in volunteering intelligence information. In celebration of the 5th Anniversary of the NLF/SVN, the Viet Cong increased propaganda activities and indoctrination throughout the western and southern areas of the

TAOR. The threatened attacks on U.S. units and installations in the Danang area never materialized. It is highly probable that the lack of VC activity during the period is due to the withdrawal of local units to base areas to train and prepare for future operations. The VC monsoon offensive never materialized due to increased patrolling by front line units and it can be expected that the Viet Cong will attempt to gain the initiative in the coming months.

e. Enemy situation at the end of the period. Enemy activity has increased in the AN MY area (AT9260) and HOI VUC (AT8770). Both of these areas are on the periphery of controlled areas and offer the Viet Cong forward operating areas in close proximity to jungle bases. The enemy initiated two incidents during the 30 hour Yuletide cease fire, although VC propagandists stated they would abide by the cease fire. Both incidents involved small arms fire delivered at friendly units. Friendly patrols have not succeeded in establishing contact with major VC units but have apparently succeeded in confining VC units to the west and south of the TAOR.

Training

a. Objectives. The battalion training program for December was designed to cover as much instruction in subjects of current importance as operational commitments would permit (see Supporting Documents, Battalion Bulletin 1500 dated 10 December 1965, Training for Month of December 1965). Besides instruction in general military subjects, specific objectives were to improve proficiency in rifle marksmanship, to improve the intelligence gathering and reporting efforts at the small unit level, and to increase proficiency in the use of the seismic intrusion device.

6. Nuclear, Biological, Chemical and other Special Types of Warfare. During the reporting period the only instance of operations in this category was on 6 December 1965 when Company "P" used two CS grenades on a suspect cave in the village of GIAO TRI (3) (AT 887701). The cave turned out to be uninhabited.

c. Attachments and Detachments

(1) There were no attachments added to the task organization of the battalion during this reporting period.

(2) Company "F" (Rein) 2nd Bn, 1st Marines replaced Company "I" (Rein) 3d Bn, 4th Marines on 21 December 1965 and is now under the operational control of 1st Bn, 1st Marines. Company "I" returned to its parent organization and is now under operational control of 3d Bn, 4th Marines.

d. Control. Control of the Battalion was exercised from the Battalion Command Post throughout the entire reporting period. Wire and radio communications continue to be used equally to exercise control over the rifle companies. On 5 December 1965 the command bunker was completed and the S-2/S-3, FSCC, and critical communications facilities commenced operating from it.

e. Problem Areas. No significant problems exist in the area of command and control.

Communication-Electronics

a. Wire. No change.

b. Radio. The battalion borrowed two AN/PRC-25 radios from FLSG for employment with a deep recon patrol. These radios have provided outstanding communications. Battery life of the BA-386/U (AN/PRC-25) has exceeded 72 hours and the batteries are still in use. It is recommended that radio sets AN/PRC-25 be allocated to the infantry battalions as soon as possible.

c. Radio relay. No change.

d. Message center/teletype. Teletype (AN/TGC-14(V)A) and crypto equipment (KW-7) have provided continuous on-line communications during December. The battalion message center handled over 400 electrically transmitted messages without an equipment failure.

e. Maintenance and supply. No change.

f. Problems encountered. The main problem during December has been the supply of small, but important items such as lance poles PO-2 (telephone poles), electrical tape and electrolyte kits for BB-451 batteries.

b. Significant Events

(1) 1 December - Company "I" patrols conducted their sweeps of the villages of PHU AUI (1), AN MY (1), AN KY (4) and (1). They found and destroyed two 81mm mortar duds and apprehended one VCS without an ID card when the patrol checked him at (AT 927610). The third platoon of Company "D" completed a psychological warfare presentation at 011630H. There were about 200 people from the village of KHUONG MY (3) in attendance. During this period there was one platoon search and clear operation, four squad and two platoon patrols, six squad and one fire team night ambushes and 29 listening posts.

(2) 2 December - Company "I" reported that at 020010H the second squad of the first platoon received automatic small arms fire and one grenade at (AT 928674). Rifle fire was returned and a grenade thrown with negative results. Two marines received very minor wounds from the grenade fragments but neither required evacuation. At 022135H and again at 022140H Company "I" received inaccurate long range sniper fire from an undetermined location. No casualties resulted. During the day, the battalion commenced execution of Frag Order 10-65 (see supporting document Part III). On this date the battalion conducted eight squad and one platoon patrols and placed 11 squad ambushes and 30 listening posts into effect.

(3) 3 December - At 030451H a returning squad ambush from Company "B" was fired on with 10 rounds of automatic fire by two VC vicinity of (AT 924601). The patrol leader was wounded in the chest and medically evacuated by helicopter. The patrol returned fire with 20 rounds and report wounding one VC who escaped. At 031045H a Company "B" platoon patrol picked up fire

and one female VCS at KHUONG MY (1) (AT 925695). suspects had improper identification. At 031415H Company "I" witnessed an explosion at (AT 927653). Upon checking, it was discovered that some Vietnamese children had been playing with either a dud or VC booby trap which detonated wounding one child and killing mother. At 031600H, the new boundaries between the 1st Battalion, 1st Marines and the 3d Battalion, 3d Marines became effective. There were four squad and two platoon patrols with eight squad ambushes and 25 listening posts out on this date.

(4) 4 December - At 040900H a squad patrol from the first platoon of Company "B" picked up two VCS, without ID cards, in the vicinity of KHUONG MY (2). At 041100H an aerial observer reported receiving small arms fire from the vicinity of HOI AN (AT 872704), while at about the same time a patrol from Company "B" destroyed a tunnel capable of holding six to eight people in the vicinity of (AT 909696). Six squad patrols, seven squad ambushes and 28 listening posts were in effect.

(5) 5 December - At 050800H Company "D" moved out in execution of Frag Order 11-65. (see after action report #4 in Part III, Supporting Documents). At 051215H Company "D" found and destroyed a booby trapped M-26 grenade at (AT 919690), and at 052050H the third platoon of Company "D" received three rounds of ineffective sniper fire from the vicinity of (AT 919690). There was one platoon and one company search and clear operation, while six squad ambushes, two squad and two platoon patrols and 26 listening posts were in operation.

(6) 6 December - At 060730H Company "D" was executing Frag Order 11-65 as modified by verbal instructions, issued when the company was unable to cross a swollen tributary of the SON TUYN RIVER. During their sweep of GIAO TRI (3) (AT 887701) the third platoon of Company "D" discovered a cave and received permission to use two CS grenades which they did with negative results. The cave was then destroyed and later at 061001H the platoon found a bear trap at coordinates (AT 889704). At 061100H the platoon received three rounds of sniper fire from the vicinity of (AT 895703). One 3.5 WP rocket was fired in response with no confirmed results. At 061300H, a platoon of PFs operating in the area made contact with eight VC near the village of KHUONG MY (2) in GS (9169). One VC was killed, one captured and six escaped. At 061330H, the third platoon of Company "C" requested a medical evacuation for two WIAs wounded by an electrically detonated mine in the vicinity (AT 905710). A subsequent search of the area failed to locate any VC. During this day there were two platoon and one company search operations, two squad and four platoon patrols, eight squad ambushes, and 30 listening posts.

(7) 7 December - At 072035H, the second platoon of Company "C" observed, illuminated and fired on two men on a road at (AT 913727) with negative results. On this date the battalion conducted eight squad patrols, nine squad ambushes and 26 listening posts.

(8) 8 December - At 081345H a psychological warfare/civil action patrol was conducted at TUY LOAN (2) grid square (AT 9269). About 150 people attended. In addition there were six squad patrols, nine ambushes and 30 listening posts out.

(9) 9 December - The first platoon of Company "B" conducted a search of DONG BICH (1) (AT 898681) in an attempt to correlate a reconnaissance patrol report received the day before concerning four bodies that were sighted hanging in the village. The patrol found no confirmation of any hangings or terrorist activity in the area but did see lifelike scarecrows which could have been mistaken for hanging bodies. Six squad patrols and ten squad night ambushes were active while 25 listening posts were put out.

(10) 10 December - The third platoon of Company "A" designated to provide convoy security under operational control of the Task Force Delta Commander for operation HARVEST MOON. At 100725H, while enroute to the Third Motor Transport Battalion, one of the M-35 trucks in which part of the platoon was riding left the muddy road and rolled over into a ditch, crushing one marine to death and injuring two others. The remainder of the third platoon continued on its mission. At 101005H a squad patrol from Company "I" apprehended two VCS without identification cards. At 101330H a psychological warfare/civic action operation was conducted in the village of PHUOC NINH (2) (AT 928668). Approximately 100 people watched the films and listened to the loudspeaker team. During this period there were seven squad patrols and eight squad ambushes in addition to 28 listening posts.

(11) 11 December - No significant events or contacts developed on this day during which the battalion conducted six squad patrols, nine squad ambushes and 29 listening posts.

(12) 12 December - At 121203H Company "D" was committed as the regimental reserve, to participate in operation HARVEST MOON under operational control of the Commander Task Force Delta. Company "C" was designated as the new regimental reserve. At 121315H Company "B" reported that a single VC had made his way through the brush to a concealed position from which he dashed toward an OP located at (AT 919690). The OP was momentarily manned by one man, whom the VC engaged with two five-round rounds and a grenade. The marine was immediately killed, and a second marine, a short distance away, went for help. Patrols were

Immediately diverted to sweep the area. Two M-14 magazines were found near KHUONG MY (2) (AT 910690) and later, six VC suspects including the wife of the VC who killed the marine, were picked up. At 121735H, the first platoon of Company "A" found one buried M-26 grenade at (AT 943680). During the reporting period, one platoon operation and four squad and two platoon patrols were conducted. Additionally, there were eight squad ambushes and 23 listening posts.

(13) 13 December - At 130900H a Company "B" patrol picked up one VCS without proper identification at KHUONG MY (1). Later in the day, at 131010H, a patrol from Company "B" attempted to apprehend a suspicious looking VCS in the vicinity of TUY LOAN (2). When the man attempted to evade the patrol he was pursued and after failing to heed appropriate warnings and continuing to run, the man was shot and apprehended in the vicinity of (AT 932697). He was subsequently evacuated for medical treatment and interrogation. At 131240H a small cave was destroyed at (AT 929687) and at 131500H the patrol from Company "B" apprehended five more VCS in the vicinity of (AT 896685) and then checked out a Vietnamese sign indicating mines and booby traps in the area. No mines or booby traps were found. Operations on this date included one platoon and several squad patrols, five squad ambushes and 23 listening posts.

(14) 14 December - At 141035H a reinforced squad patrol from Company "C" was moving up a narrow draw at (AT 896735) when the point was charged by eight unattended water buffalo. The patrol was forced to shoot all of the buffalo to prevent injury to themselves. At 141420H a patrol from the first platoon of Company "B" apprehended one VCS at (AT 901681). In the evening at 141845H, a squad from the first platoon of Company "I" had a meeting engagement with one VC, vicinity of (AT 939679). The point and the VC spotted each other simultaneously and the VC fired 10 rounds from a submachine gun while the point returned fire with one magazine from his M-14 and reported that one tracer round hit the VC's hip and weapon, causing him to fall down. The VC got up and moved rapidly into a nearby tree line from which he fired one more burst at the pursuing patrol. The area was searched with negative results. There were four squad and four platoon patrols in addition to six squad ambushes and 23 listening posts in position this date.

(15) 15 December - The only incident during the day occurred about 152000H when Company "I" reported an AN/TPS 21 contact about 10 degrees in width and 1000 meters South of hill 41, vicinity of coordinates (AT 928653). The target appeared to be a column of about 15 troops moving toward hill 41. Fire missions were called and executed with 81mm mortars, 105mm howitzers and 90mm tank guns. The size of the column appeared to tighten up and the AN/TPS 21 showed the target reversing direction and moving out of sight from the hills to the southwest. A patrol was immediately dispatched.

to check out the area for damage assessment, and although a spotter on hill 41 reported the rounds on target, no indication of casualties inflicted were found. Of the six patrols run on 15 December, one was a platoon and the other five squad size, while six squad ambushes were emplaced along with 23 listening posts.

(16) 16 December - There were no contacts in the battalion TAOR on 16 December. A patrol sent out to make a daylight check of the impact area of the target picked up by the AN/TPS 21 the previous night found many footprints and one straw hat with a hole in it at the target area. At 161340H one female VCS without ID card was picked up and taken to the district chief for interrogation. There was one platoon and five squad patrols plus eight squad ambushes and 23 listening posts out this date.

(17) 17 December - There were no significant events in the battalion TAOR this date although the battalion ran one platoon search and clear operation of KHUONG MY (2) while six squad and one platoon size patrols were active. There were six squad ambushes and 27 listening posts in effect in the TAOR of the First Battalion, First Marines.

(18) 18 December - At 181915H, while getting into an ambush position at (AT 943677), the leader of the third platoon, Company "I" ambushed tripped an explosive device (probably a booby trap, 81mm Mortar round) in the center of the ambush site and the resulting explosion killed one Marine and wounded four who were immediately medically evacuated. The ambush was moved to a new location and the next morning, an engineer sweep of the same site located four booby trapped M-26 grenades. At 182130H, Company "D" listening post #1 (AT 928717) fired two M-79 rounds and 8-10 rounds of small arms fire at suspected V.C. movement. While, at about the same time, listening post #2 (AT 933718) sighted two V.C. several hundred meters away and fired 10-12 rounds after having received one incoming round of small arms fire. There were no confirmed casualties on either side. On this date, the battalion conducted seven squad patrols and six ambushes while 24 night listening posts were out.

(19) 19 December - This was a relatively quiet day during which a patrol from the second platoon of Company "B" apprehended one male VCS at 191000H vicinity of (AT 900684). At 191400H Company "I" held a civil action operation at the base of hill 41, where gifts and medical care were given. About 50 persons attended the highly successful activity. There were five daylight squad and one platoon patrols in operation and nine ambushes and 24 listening posts were in effect.

(20) 20 December - At 201020H the first platoon of Company "I" patrol was taken under fire by approximately 10 V.C. with a light machine gun. One Marine was wounded and medically evacuated. A fire mission was called on the V.C. (AT 920603) with unconfirmed results. At 201105H the third platoon of Company "B" destroyed a booby trapped gate at (AT 903705). At 201215H the first platoon of Company "I" received sporadic sniper fire from two V.C. vicinity of (AT 925606). Fire was returned with negative results. The village of AN MY (3) had recent fortifications, including fresh punji stakes, and was flying an NLF flag which was taken by the Marines. At 201400H the first platoon of Company "I" picked up 3 VCS in the area of (AT 920603) and 9 more VCS 1000 meters North of AN MY (3). The suspects were taken to the district chief for evaluation. At 202150H an ambush from the third platoon of Company "B" fired on four V.C and received fire from their position vicinity of woodline (AT 911701). There were no friendly casualties and no confirmed V.C. casualties. During this period there were six squad and one platoon patrols, nine squad ambushes and 24 listening posts. Company "D" returned to Opcon of 1/1 202250H.

(21) 21 December - At 210905H a patrol from the second platoon of Company "B" received four rounds of sniper fire from KHUONG MY (2). Fire was returned and one V.C. was fatally wounded. The V.C., who later died of wounds, was captured at (AT 909694) along with a hard hat, grenades and cartridge belt that he had discarded. At 211110H the second platoon of Company "B" picked up a VCS at (AT 909689). A scout/sniper team was employed during daylight hours to cover a spot where artillery communications wire had been repeatedly cut for several days. The team found no targets. There were also five squad and two platoon patrols along with ten squad ambushes and 24 listening posts.

(22) 22 December - This was an uneventful day during which the battalion conducted six squad and two platoon patrols along with eight squad ambushes and 22 listening posts. There was one exchange of small arms fire at 222330H when post #15 in the battalion CP reported movement and 3 incoming rounds of sniper fire from about 300 yards away. Fire was returned with negative results.

(23) 23 December - At 200700H Company "D" commenced execution of Frag Order 12-05 (see Part III Supporting Documents). At 231155H a Company "B" patrol picked up two VCS without proper identification at (AT 895675). At 231310H the patrol found a VC flag 28x34" at (AT 935705). At 231313H the third platoon of Company "D" received two bursts of automatic fire consisting of approximately 15 rounds and fired from the vicinity of coordinates (AT 888725). Fire was returned with M-16 arms and M-79 rounds and the enemy ceased fire. At 231700H, the first platoon of Company "D" discovered a Chinese grenade rigged as a booby trap (AT 870715), which was destroyed in place. Enemy sniper fire was received at this time and the second platoon of Company "C" became engaged in a fire fight with about four to five VC across the river vicinity of (AT 874713). The VC were wearing helmet-type headgear, web gear, khaki uniforms and carried carbines. CHARLIE Two commenced firing with all organic weapons. One VC was killed, and one VC was wounded. There were no Marine casualties. In addition to the Company "D" search and destroy operation (see after-action report #5 in part III, Supporting Documents) there were seven squad and two platoon patrols with eight squad ambushes and 22 listening post employed.

(24) 24 December - At 241545H the second platoon of Company "C" suffered nine WILs (none serious) vicinity (AT 890000) caused by a home made booby trap thought to consist of about two and a half pounds of TNT and wrapped with barbed wire. A temporary "cease fire" was placed into effect at 241800H and offensive operations were terminated during the period of the cease fire. However, at 241845H, the first platoon of Company "D" received approximately 30-35 rounds fired simultaneously from several locations in the vicinity of HOI VUC (AT 8770). The platoon was forced to defend itself and returned fire with all weapons organic to the company in addition to requesting an artillery fire mission. The unfordable river prevented the Marines from closing with the enemy and there were no confirmed casualties on either side. In addition to the continuing Delta Company search and destroy operation there were seven squad and one platoon patrols with seven ambushes and 22 listening posts employed.

(25) 25 December - At 250800H a helilift commenced to extract Company "D" from the area of operations. There were eight to ten exchanges of sporadic small arms fire coming from HOI VUC area, and directed to the helicopters during the lifts. Fire was returned with all organic company weapons and with unconfirmed results. Several helicopters were hit by small arms fire causing one crew member to be wounded in the arm and one Marine from Company "D" to be superficially wounded in the leg. The lift was completed at 250855H. There were no other significant events on this Christmas day during which a cease fire remained in effect until 252400H. Offensive operations were cancelled during the period but 24 listening posts were in effect.

(26) 26 December - At 261155H Company "F" diverted a platoon from a civil action patrol to sweep PHUOC NINH (1) (AT 943675) in response to a report by a small Vietnamese boy that some VC were located in the area. The sweep was conducted with negative results. An aerial observer was on station to coordinate the sweep and he received small arms fire at coordinates (AT 960573) and (AT 972573). At 261649H the patrol of the third platoon of Company "B" picked up one VCS with false identification at (AT 898695). At 261930H Bravo Company received 30-40 rounds of ineffective small arms fire from several hundred meters South of their CP but were unable to determine the location. There were two platoon search and destroy operations, four squad and two platoon patrols, eight squad ambushes and 26 listening posts on the 26th of December

(27) 27 December - At 270945H the first platoon of Company "B", while on patrol, picked up a confirmed VC. There were no other significant events during this day on which the battalion conducted one squad and one platoon patrol, eight squad ambushes, 28 listening posts and one scout/sniper team.

(28) 28 December - At 281325H the squad reconnaissance patrol of Company "D" sighted three VC in the distance moving from (AT 870706) to (AT 875707). Due to the distance involved, and the mission of the patrol, additional information could not be determined, nor aggressive action taken. A squad reconnaissance patrol each from Companies "C" and "D" have been helilifted into the HOI VUC area in order to maintain observation over the landing zone in preparation for the execution of Frag Order 13-65. There were one platoon and ten squad patrols while 10 squad ambushes and 28 listening posts were active this date.

(29) 29 December - At 290935H a patrol from Company "B" picked up two VCS caught cutting communications wire vicinity (AT 916697). Both had improper ID cards and were thought to be VC. At 291430H the patrol from the third platoon of Company "B" apprehended a VCS at (AT 908696). At 292050H a patrol from the third platoon of Company "C" received about 20 rounds of small arms fire from an undetermined position about 300 meters south of their position at (AT 967719). Execution of Battalion Frag Order 13-65 was delayed until 30 December 1965, due to inclement weather which caused a cancellation of the heli-lift. The two squads from Companies "C" and "D" continue to maintain surveillance over the landing zones. During this day there were six patrols and 11 ambushes of squad size and 26 listening posts in position.

(30) 30 December - 300930H ...
tion of Battalion Frag Order 13-65. There was no contact in the landing zone however, helicopters received scattered small arms fire when leaving the landing zone and flying over the HOI VUC complex (AT 8770). At 301200H the first platoon of Company destroyed an unoccupied cave and two tunnels in the vicinity (AT 873706). A bear trap was found in one of the caves. Company "C" reported a booby trapped grenade was set off, slightly injuring two Marines. At 301255H the second platoon of Company "D" found about 4,000 pounds of rice at coordinates (AT 878705). Arrangements are being made to evacuate the rice, via helicopter to District Headquarters. At 301315H four more unoccupied caves were destroyed by the second platoon of Company "D". No enemy contact was developed in the HOI VUC complex during the sweep or destroy operation which will continue on 31 December. In addition to the two-company search and destroy operation there were one platoon and three squad size patrols. Seven squad ambushes, 26 listening posts and two scout sniper teams were also employed.

(31) 31 December - Execution of Frag Order 13-65 continued at first light. At 310915H, Company "D" found another 1500 pounds of rice (AT 873705). By 311110H CHARLIE Three had destroyed several caves and a tunnel at vicinity (AT 894709), (AT 887700) and (AT 890705). One Marine from Company "C" who had a fever was evacuated at 311450H. At 311600H, Company "D" completed its sweep of HOI VUC. Company "C" proceeded to return to its CP, and the evacuation of the rice (including the rice found on 30 December) to Sierra began. Two platoons of Company "D" were helilifted at 311700H back to Company "D" CP. Delta 2 is to remain in the operation area until 1 January. No VC contact was made during the operation. In addition to the operation, the battalion conducted 11 squad size ambushes, 26 fire team listening posts, 6 squad and 1 platoon sized patrols. Scout sniper teams were used 3 times. No contact was made by any patrol although Bravo 3 patrol picked up a VCS at 311515H (AT 922699) who had 2 I.D.'s and was taken to Sierra. Foxtrot 1A ambush had a grenade explode near its position (AT 925673) at 312000H which was not thrown or tripped by the patrol. In addition, about 20 villagers from PHU SON (4) (AT 945637) came to Hill 41 to complain about H&I fires. They were referred to Sierra and Swain was informed.

Fire Support and Fire Support Coordination

1. There were no significant events in the area of fire support coordination. No difficulties were encountered in providing sufficient fire support for the operational requirements of the battalion.

(1) The artillery defensive fire plan was revised to conform to the changes in the MFR.

(2) Extensive harassing and interdiction fires were continued throughout the month, and artillery fired 1013 missions.

(3) The 81mm Mortar Platoon fired 947 harassing and interdiction missions.

(4) During the month artillery fired five observed WE missions in support of battalion operations.

(5) Two illumination missions were fired by artillery during the month.

(6) On 31 December the fire support annex was submitted for 1st Battalion, 1st Marine Operation Order 130-65.

Logistics

a. Supply

(1) In-kind clothing issues were made to all companies including an initial issue to Company F, 2d Battalion, 1st Marines (OPCON to 1/1/68). Socks and 10 combat boots were in short supply, but other requirements were filled in sufficient quantities.

(2) A 752 equipment issue/survey program was initiated by Battalion Supply providing service at each company location. The program was effective and will be utilized in the future when required.

(3) Substantial quantities of dry cell batteries were received this month. At present there is an adequate stock of all types of batteries on hand.

(4) Thirteen Winchester Model 12 shotguns were received and issued (Three per rifle company and one to H&S Company). Ordnance deadline has remained low with three 3.5 rocket launchers and one M-79 grenade launcher on deadline at present.

(5) Two boats were issued to this unit for logistical and tactical use.

(6) Two Critipak shipments were received this month. Items received were not of a critical nature on the whole, but several items were necessary and helpful in supplementing normal supply requirements. The majority of requisitions filled this month were completed through the Critipak program.

b. Maintenance. The average daily rate of vehicles on deadline was:

- (1) M-274 (Mechanical Mule) 50% (15 of 30) *
- (2) M-422 (Mighty Mito) 20% (4 of 20)

(2) One company, one platoon, and two squad outposts subsist on "C" rations with supplements provided by the Battalion mess.

(1) The cantonment program is ~~not~~ complete. No construction has taken place during the last two weeks of the month. Critical structures/ items needed are:

- (e) Screen wire (72 rolls)

e. Transportation

(1) The M-76 "Otter" provided excellent service during the month. The "Otter" was able to traverse roads that were impassable to all other type vehicles enabling the Battalion to continue normal operation. At the end of the month the "Otter" was withdrawn and replaced with six 1 ton trucks instead of the normal eight vehicles. This loss of the two vehicles created considerable problems for the battalion transportation commitments.

(2) The roads are in extremely poor condition due to the heavy rainfall during the month. Traffic limitations have been imposed in an effort to lessen the amount of traffic on the roads during the heaviest rain periods. The engineers continue work to improve the road network.

f. Water

(1) One M-170 water trailer has been removed from service because of possible contamination. (Contamination resulted from metal used in construction)

(2) The relocation of the water point within the battalion security area has not been accomplished. The request was submitted in October 1965.

- d. Number of Combat Casualties Treated: One(1) minor battle casualty was treated at the BAS. The majority of battle casualties were evacuated by Helicopter from the battle zone directly to "C" Company, 3rd Medical Battalion. The total number of combat casualties for the month of December was nineteen(19) WIA and one(1) KIA.
- e. Number of Non-battle Casualties Treated: Five hundred fifteen (515) patients were treated at the BAS for non-combat casualties. One(1) DOA who was involved in a vehicular accident was brought to the BAS before being transferred to "C" Med.

3. Civil Affairs/Military Government/Community Relations (S-1)
Civil Affairs Officer)

a. Significant Activities.

(1) Medical Assistance. During the month of December 1st Battalion, 1st Marines MEDCAP sickcall treated 2,889 Vietnamese civilians, and have given 3,161 treatments. Since 1 September 1965, 1st Battalion, 1st Marines MEDCAP program has treated more than 11,294 Vietnamese civilians throughout its TAOR. 1,376 Vietnamese civilians were treated by the Hieu Duc District Dispensary, located in the hamlet of TUY LOAN (AT 945699). The Battalion Surgeon and two corpsman assisted the staff of the dispensary on 3, 7, 23, 28 and 31 December. During these five days, the Battalion Surgeon treated 363 local villagers at sickcall. On 7 December, a Dentist from 3rd Dental Company and one dental technician assisted the Battalion Surgeon at sickcall and treated 12 villagers. A total of 25 teeth were extracted during the treatments. During December, a total of seven (7) Vietnamese civilians were medically evacuated to the USOM Hospital in Da Nang by the Battalion Aid Station.

(2) Psychological Warfare/Civil Action Patrols. During December, 1st Battalion, 1st Marines conducted a total of five (5) such patrols. On 1 December, PsyWar/Civil Action Patrol was conducted in TUY LOAN (1) hamlet, (AT 940715). On 7 December, PsyWar/Civil Action Patrol was conducted in HOA PHU hamlet, (AT 913742). On 8 December, PsyWar/Civil Action Patrol was conducted in KHUONG MY (1) hamlet, (AT 925684). On 10 December, PsyWar/Civil Action Patrol was conducted in PHUOC BINH (2) hamlet, (AT 928668). On 22 December, PsyWar/Civil Action Patrol was conducted in PHUOC HUNG hamlet, (AT 920726). An average of 250 villagers were in attendance at each location. (See Civil Affairs Daily Sit-Reps for December on above dates in PART III, SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS).

(3) Countryside Band Concerts. On 15 December, a 18 piece band from the 3rd Marine Division Band, gave a one hour band concert on the lawn of HOA HUNG village (AT 945699) headquarters for approximately 200 villagers. The band was so well received by its audience, that it returned on 28 December for another such concert. This performance was played in the HOA HUNG village market place by a 40 piece band. 1,500 persons were in attendance. The band played for two hours and received much applause after each song. Of note was the band's ability to play several Vietnamese songs which provided a great deal of enjoyment for the surprised villagers attending the concert.

d. Appendix Results of Civil Affairs program.

(1) During December, each company has continued to consolidate their positions and has made daily contact with the villagers in the respective company sectors. Every effort has been made to consult with village or hamlet chiefs prior to undertaking any action which may affect the local population.

(2) Of particular note is the definite increase in the friendliness of the villagers through the controlled areas of 1st Battalion, 1st Marines TAOR. Practically all villagers traveling along the roads within the MLR wave and say hello to any Marine who passes them either on foot or in a vehicle.

UD Doctor Explores New Face Of Viet War

An Upper Darby Navy Lieutenant with medical training is playing a major role in a new kind of war in Vietnam. This is a kind of war that many observers believe may have a greater impact on world peace than conventional fighting has had so far.

One scene of that war, as described by eyewitnesses, would go like this:

A villager in the tiny settlement of Phouch Nhin would come forward to a mobile dispensary, set up by Marines of the 3d Battalion 4th Marine Regiment. Lt. John E. Becker, from Upper Darby, would ask "What seems to be bothering you?" A translator would act as the intermediate and the villager with a baby in one arm would reply: "I can't sleep at night because of pains in my back."

Dr. Becker would examine him, prescribe some treatment and feasible medication, and call for the next patient.

The new "war", known as MEDCAP (Medical Civilian Assistance Program) would continue throughout the day as villager after villager would come forward and describe his symptoms. The first MEDCAP team is composed of one civil affairs officer, one doctor and

three corpsmen. The new "war" has the same battle-

ground as the conventional war in Vietnam and the Viet

Cong may always be found somewhere in the bleachers.

U.S. Team Does Job In Hoa Loc

DA NANG, Vietnam (ISO) — The Marine Corps-Navy civil affairs team of the 1st Bn., 1st Marine Regt., 3d Marine Div., has enlisted the aid of the U.S. Army in a people-to-people program in a village near here.

Working closely with the Marines and the Navy corpsmen in the village of Hoa Loc is an Army psychological warfare team whose purpose is to counter Viet Cong anti-American propaganda.

The Army's psywar team adds another facet to the Marines' successful civil affairs program by showing the Vietnamese through magazines and motion pictures ways to improve farming methods and raise crop yields.

While the 1st Bn. Marines goes about the business of distributing soap, food and clothing, a Navy medical team treats villagers for cuts, infections and skin diseases. At the same time the Army psywar team makes a house-to-house visit distributing information filled magazines and talking with the villagers.

Highlight of the 1st Bn.'s effort is an evening movie, usually shown at the village school house.

The civil affairs team said newsreels showing the truth of the war in Vietnam always play to a full house."

Now No Bullets

The civil affairs team of the 1st Bn., First Marine Regiment, 3rd Marine Division, is not a timid crew. In performing their function of giving medical help to Vietnamese villagers and distributing gifts of clothing and food from the United States, they do not limit themselves to safe areas of the countryside.

Recently, accompanied by a squad of Marines, the team penetrated into an area normally seen only by heavily armed patrols.

In a small hamlet near Da Nang, Vietnamese interpreters announced the presence of the "bocsi" (doctors) over a loud speaker.

Despite pouring rain, a crowd soon gathered around the Americans to receive treatment from the Navy corpsman.

After the medical team finished their work, Marines passed out clothing and canned foods to the Vietnamese.

The team members are convinced that their audacity is paying off. Navy corpsman Robert LeBlanc (Windsor, Ontario, Canada) feels their work is effecting a permanent change in the people's attitude toward health and cleanliness.

The daily visits to the countryside are showing definite results, according to 1stLt. Jim Keeley, battalion civil affairs officer. "In the beginning, nobody waved at you on the road, and you couldn't go out without getting shot at."

Now the team is greeted by friendly waves and shouts almost anywhere they go in the battalion area.
