NARRATIVE SUMMARY

On 12 July 1967, the platoon at Operation CUMBERLAND sustained an estimated 50-70 round 82mm mortar attack. The attack resulted in 1 friendly WIA.


On 17 July 1967, the platoon of 155mm Guns at (YD 716106) was released from its support of Operation CUMBERLAND and returned to the battery position at PHU BAI, RVN (YD 893127).

On 31 July 1967, a platoon of 155mm Guns were placed OPCON ~~to~~ 1st MAG.

During the month of July, the battery continued to improve its defensive positions and defensive counter-attack plans. Seven new bunkers were built and situated within the perimeter to serve as both mortar bunkers and a second line of defense.

Education and training continued with classes in General Military Subjects and on the job training. Classes were held in First Aid, Venereal Disease, Assembly and Disassembly of M-16, Intelligence briefings, Patrol and LP Techniques, and NBC Defense.

- 1 July 1967 - 17 July - 1st Platoon, 1st 155mm Gun Battery (SP) Support Operation CUMBERLAND and Direct Support designated Recon Patrols.
- 31 July - 1st Platoon, 1st 155mm Gun Battery was placed OPCON to 1st Field Artillery Group.

3. Maintenance. During this period two Guns, 155mm (SP) M-53 had Quarterly Preventive Maintenance held. One weapon is deadlined for 3rd and 4th echelon maintenance.

4. Bunkers and Perimeter Security. During the month of July, seven

new bunkers were built within the perimeter to serve as both Motar bunkers and a second line of defense. The Battery has continued to improve its defensive positions and defensive counter-attack plans. A continued wire laying effort has resulted in a network of wire designed to both impede and channelize the enemy.

5. Water. The battery continues to truck water from the Division water point.
- f. Civic Action. During this period the battery assumed the responsibilities of the Civil Action Program in the Village Loc Bon (YD 926130). Several Med Caps and one Dent Cap have been held. The battery has begun its program to refurbish the center of the village.
- g. Administration The Battery is ADCON, 4th Battalion, 12th Marines.
