PART II
NARRATIVE SUMMARY

Battalion operations for this reporting period were highlighted by participation in Operation Perry. A platoon of LVTP5's and six (6) LVTE1's were employed by 2/7 to displace and relocate the inhabitants of the villages located in the area. The LVTP5's transported approximately 3,000 villagers and the LVTE1's fired nine (9) line charges containing 15,750 pounds of C-4. An area equivalent to 4½ hectares was cleared of suspected mines, booby traps, and vegetation. It was observed also that the use of the LVT's had a tremendous psychological effect upon the Vietnamese Nationals. Five (5) LVTP5's were placed in direct support of 2/7 after the operation terminated.

The battalion continued operations in support of 1/5, 3/5, 1/7, 3/7, MCB 8, and Chu Lai Defense Command. One hundred (100) resupply missions, nine (9) search and clear missions, twenty (20) river patrols, and fifteen (15) MedCaps were conducted in the TAORS, using LVT's. MCB 8 employed LVT's on their MedCaps.

Three (3) LVT's and one (1) LVTR1 were provided to operate in conjunction with "A" Company, 1st Tank Bn., in support of 3/7 on Operation Desote. These LVT's transported a compressor for the Flame Tanks. The LVTR1 crew performed major repairs on two (2) disabled Tanks.

On 31 March, fifteen (15) LVT's were committed in support of 1/7 on Operation Boone. At the end of March, fifty-five (55) of the sixty-five (65) LVT's possessed were committed. As detailed in enclosure (2), this included logistic support, reaction force support, in addition to combat support missions.

The Battalion continues to provide the Command/Control (COC) for Sub-Sector V, CLDC.

PART III
SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1. TOPICS

a. Personnel and Administration.

(1) During the reporting period one (1) USMC Officer, Zero (0) Navy Officers and forty-five (45) USMC Enlisted, two (2) Navy Enlisted rotated to CONUS. Two (2) USMC Officers, Zero (0) Navy Officers, seventy-eight (78) USMC Enlisted and Zero (0) Navy Enlisted replacements were received.

(2) During the reporting period the battalion had the following casualties: Six (6) WIA.

(3) The following awards were presented to personnel of the Battalion during this period: Four (4) Purple Hearts.

b. Intelligence

(1) Two (2) LVT's were mined resulting in minor damage to one (1). The second received considerable damage and will be evacuated to CONUS. There were two (2) incidents of harrassing fire.

(2) Normal administrative and combat intelligence functions were carried out during the month. Four (4) ground reconnaissances were conducted in proposed areas of operation to determine trafficability.

(3) Continued emphasis was placed upon the people-to-people programs. A thorough indoctrination is being given to all personnel reporting into the Battalion.

(4) On two occasions LVT's were used to transport injured or wounded Vietnamese children to medical facilities.

c. Training

(1) Formal training was conducted throughout the month in conjunction with operational commitments. Special emphasis was placed on proper reporting procedures, Map reading, night water driving operations, first aid, and indoctrination of newly arrived personnel.

(2) FAM Firing was conducted during the month with rifles, pistols, and 1919A4 Machine Guns.

(3) OJT and normal maintenance procedures were conducted during the month.

d. Schools

(1) Eight (8) Enlisted personnel attended a second echelon maintenance course on the New Family of FM/radics.

(2) Ten (10) Enlisted personnel attended Land Mine Warfare School.

e. Special Operations.

(1) Enclosure (2) contains the Battalion's Sit Reps for 1-31 Mar, 1967.

f. Logistics

(1) Significant Events

(a) The final phase of Battalion encampment construction will commence on 7 April. The building will consist of a 40' x 196' Butler Building that will house the Battalion's Maintenance/Supply Warehouse. All other phases of camp development are complete.

(2) Supply

(a) The major supply effort was focused on requisitions for LVT suspension parts in order to build up dependable operating levels of these critical items.

g. Civic Action

(1) A dispensary being built by villagers for use of MEDCAP and DENCAP has been completed. The number of patients treated declined slightly from the average. This is probably due to the death of an elder in the hospital after being evacuated. The attitude of the villagers has begun to improve again after the setback caused by the elder's death. A demonstration garden has been started, and construction by villagers of a Farmer's Association building has begun.

3. Contacts.

a. At 0915 on 27 March a mine was detonated by a C Company, 1/5 infantryman while on a sweep of Cigar with three (3) LVT's at coordinates 355285. Two C Company, 1/5 personnel were KIA, and one wounded. The KIA's were carried by LVT to coordinates 441165 and picked up by helicopters.

b. At 1215, on 27 March, two (2) LVT's were returning from 355285 moving south. A charge was detonated 5 feet from the starboard side of one LVT. Twenty to thirty rounds of automatic fire was received from a junk off shore and from the land to the rear of the LVT. They returned 50 rounds, .30 Cal and M-14 fire each into the land area.

c. At 1400, 27 March at coordinates 369265, three (3) LVT's were returning south when they received 30 to 50 rounds of small arms fire, from approximately the same position as the two (2) LVT's in 3.2. They returned 50 rounds .30 Cal each and the enemy fire ceased. No wounded.

4. Battalion Plans.

a. 3d Antrac Bn has tentatively scheduled a three (3) LVT reconnaissance along the trail system in the vicinity of coordinates 415075 to the west of Hill 100 on 31 March in conjunction with M company, 3/5.

5. Administrative.

a. One (1) LVTR1A1 and one (1) LVTP5A1 went aboard LST 1170 at 1900 on the 23 March, 1967. Their mission was to carry a tank engine to the Duc Pho area to repair a deadlined tank. The two (2) LVT's landed at Duc Pho around 1400, 24 March, 1967. The recovery crews began immediately making repairs on two (2) M-48A3 Tanks and one (1) LVTP5A1. In order to replace the damaged Tank engine it was necessary to separate the cross drive transmission and reinstall it on the replacement engine. The job was completed in 12 hours. The recovery crew then removed the power pack assembly from a second M-48A3 Tank to replace a failed generator. This was accomplished in about 4 hours. While the Tanks were being repaired, the LVTR1A1 welder installed an inboard adapter for a torsion arm assembly on an LVTP5A1. All repairs were completed by 1400, 25 March, 1967. At 1415, 25 Mar, 67, the LVTR1A1 was requested to recover two (2) M-48A3's that were mired and had broken track. The LVTR1A1 crew repaired the broken track and had both Tanks returned to service by 0700 on 26 Mar, 67. The LVTR1A1 is still attached to the unit at Duc Pho Combat Base. As a result of this success, we have learned that an LVTR1A1 and crew can handle any recovery repair operation required by the 52 ton M-48A3 90mm Gun Tank.

b. Six LVTR1A1's employed in operation Perry fired a total of nine (9) line charges, clearing an area of 4½ hectares. The nine (9) charges consisted of 15,750 pounds of C-4. The area of impact was comprised of cane fields, rice paddies, and villages which had been evacuated. The entire 4½ hectares were completely cleared of vegetation and structures, uncovering numerous caves and rice caches. Suspected mine & booby trapped areas were also cleared.
