COMMANDERS NARRATIVE SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

During the month of November the prisoner strength, III MAF Brig, was 217, an increase of 11 over the month of October. The average weekly detainee strength in the III MAF Detention Facility was 75. A seven (7) vehicle, fifty (50) man special security detail was provided for Vice President HUMPHREY and party during a tour of III MAF Headquarters and NSA Hospital. Throughout the month special escorts were provided General CUSHMAN and General OLSON. During November General IRVINE, U.S. Army, visited the III MAF Detention Facility. Gunnery Sergeant PALMER relieved Gunnery Sergeant ASH as H&S Company First Sergeant. 2nd Lieutenant F. P. MARONEY was the III MAF Official Escort for two Military Bands and one USO Handshaking tour with the "Rat Patrol", television personalities. On 16 November 1st Lieutenants CRANE, FIRTH and NELSON were promoted to their present rank. During the month special security details were provided for Vice President KY. 1st Lieutenant F. H.
