COMMANDER'S NARRATIVE SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

During the month of July an Armed Propaganda Team consisting of two Chieu Hoi returnees was furnished to 3d MPBn for utilization in our hamlets. A school addition was completed in Thach Nham (H), which extends the school capacity to one hundred and fifty students. One concrete water well was completed in Phuoc Thuan (H). The MED CAP total for the month was three hundred thirty-one (331) people treated, two being hospitalized. The average prisoner strength in the III MAF Brig for July was 278. The average weekly strength in the III MAF Detention Facility for July was 134.

A visit to the Detention Facility was made by Colonel WEBER, USA. Cpl A. M. SHERP 225091 WIA in Phu Bai, RVN, Cpl E. J. HATENBERGER 2263571 WIA Quang RVN, Sgt J. M. TURNER Jr. 2356915 WIA Chu Lai, RVN, LCpl T. F. RYAN 2271631 WIA An Hoa RVN. Escorts were provided by Armed Forces Police for Lieutenant General SOLOMON, General BEACH, General WISEMAN, General TOMPkins, Admiral OSBORN, General ROSEN. Two meetings of the Combined Police Coordinating Committee were held during the month of July 1968. The committee in conjunction with the local TV Station AFVN made a twelve minute film showing the more common traffic violations which are the major cause of accidents in Quang, RVN.
