COMMANDER'S NARRATIVE SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

During the month of May the average monthly strength in the III MAF Brig was 239. The average monthly strength for the III MAF Detention Facility was 32. Med Caps were held in the hamlets of Thach Nham, Hoa Khuong, and Phuoc Thuan. The total attendance for the month was 120. Medications and immunizations were given to the ill. Armed Force Police continued to fulfill their mission of providing Law Enforcement in DaNang and security for I Corps Advisory Facilities during the month of May. Increased emphasis was placed on the control of excessive speed in, and around the city, with excellent results. Escorts were provided for LtGen H. NICKERSON, and Gen H. X. LAM. Cpl H. E.
