COMMANDER'S NARRATIVE SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

During the month of June the average monthly population of the III MAF Correctional Center was 231. Med Caps were provided twice a week in the Hamlets of Thach Nham and Nghi An. Total attendance for the month of June was 542. Medications and immunizations were given to the ill, and the Dent Cap treated 15 patients. Armed Forces Police continued to fulfill its mission of providing Law Enforcement in the City of Danang, RVN, and security for the American Consulate. On 1 June 1970, Company B was reduced to zero strength and the Security Element was transferred to H&S Company. On 15 June 1970, the 504th Military Police Battalion, U. S. Army, assumed OPCON of Armed Forces Police Danang. On 27 June, the Headquarters of Company D displaced from the 5th Communication Battalion cantonment to the 3d Military Police Battalion cantonment. The I Corps Combined Narcotic Team conducted three (3) Operations, resulting in the confiscation of eleven thousand four hundred and fifty (11,450) marijuana cigarettes, eleven (11) kilograms of bulk marijuana and six hundred (600) bottles of Obesitol. The three (3) Operations also resulted in the arrest of six (6) Vietnamese Nationals. On 26 June 1970, Mine and Booby Trap Dog Platoon conducted a demonstration for the Honorable John CHAFEE, Secretary of the Navy. On 29 June 1970, Dog Operations conducted a demonstration for Colonel Garth K. STURDEVAN, USMC, incoming Chief of Staff, Force Logistic Command.
