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Present officer strength is 43 with an authorized manning level of 42. A total of 83 enlisted men were lost due to normal attrition. Enlisted strength is 730 compared to an authorized manning level of 743. The battalion is reinforced by one company of Anti-Tanks and one medium tank platoon. Although the overall numbers of enlisted personnel are adequate, a shortage of effective tank crewman in the Staff NCO ranks exists. The average number of tank crewmen for the month of January was 267.

The battalion joined 9 officers and 127 enlisted. Losses were 5 officers and 83 enlisted.

Five requests for extension of overseas tours were forwarded during January. The extension total 28 man-months gained through extensions for the period 1 January to 31 January. The major factor of extension of overseas tour is the special 30 day leave program.

The battalion sustained 22 casualties during January. Two were KIA, and twenty sustained wounds as a result of enemy action. Three personnel are listed as MIA since 8 January. There were three non-hostile casualties.

No court-martials were held during January. There were eleven instances of punishment under Article 15, UCMJ in the battalion.

Battalion level administration and personnel accounting continued to present no major problems.

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OPERATIONS AND TRAINING

Activity during January continued at the same pace as in the past few months until the arrival of TET when action increased significantly.

During the 1-25 January tanks of this Battalion participated in 5 operations.

Operation Kentucky. Tanks of Company "A" and one platoon of Company "A", 3d Anti-Tank Battalion supported the 2d Battalion, 4th Marine Regiment and the 12th Provisional Artillery Battalion. Tanks fired 90mm HE and WP, H&I fires and fired 90mm direct and indirect at known and suspected enemy positions resulting in one KIA (confirmed). On 5 January a platoon from the Special Landing Force was chopped to this Battalion and was redesignated the 3d Platoon, Company "G". This platoon was in support of the 3d Battalion, 4th Marine Regiment and the 1st and 3d Battalion, 3d Marine Regiment at A-3.

Operation Lancaster. Tanks of "B" Company participated in this operation in the Camp Carroll-Rockpile areas in support of the 2d and 3d Battalion, 9th Marine Regiment. Support included firing 90mm HE H&I fires and providing escorts for seven convoys from Thom San Lam to Cau Lu. On 13 January the convoy was ambushed by an estimated reinforced NVA Company. The tanks fired 90mm HE and cannister and 30 and 50 caliber machine guns at ambush positions with unknown results. On 24 January two tanks from Camp Carroll went out as part of a reaction force to assist a company which had been ambushed on Route# 9. The reaction force was also ambushed and the tanks suffered one KIA and one WIA. Tank B42 was hit by an RPG and evacuated to DongHa where it was repaired and returned to service.

Operation Scotland. Company "A", 3d Anti-Tank Battalion and the 3d Platoon of Company "B" supported the 26th Marine Regiment in this operation in the Kho Sanh area. Tank 90mm fire at enemy mortar positions resulted in one secondary explosion.

Operation Noosho. Tanks of Company "C" fired 90mm H&I fires in support of the 1st Battalion, 9th Marine Regiment during the operation in the Phong Dien Area.

Operation Napoleon. Two tanks of Company "C" participated in this operation in support of the 1st Amphibian Tractor Battalion. The tanks fired machine guns at observed enemy movement and on 19 January participated as part of a reaction force to engage an enemy unit. The tanks fired 90mm HE, cannister and WP as well as 30 and 50 caliber machine guns accounting for 17 KIA (confirmed).

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On 25 January Company "C" less two tanks at Cua Viet and one platoon at A-3, displaced from Camp Evans. The Company was to move to Quang Tri. While enroute down the Cua Viet River on LCU's the tanks came under small arms and recoilless rifle fire. The tanks returned fire with 50 caliber machine guns with unknown results. Upon arrival in Dong Ha these tanks were diverted to the "A" Company Command Post and are now operating out of that position.

During the period 26 to 31 January tank actions were varied and wide spread.

On 26 January tanks of Company "A" went on a sweep with elements of the 2d Battalion, 1st Marine Regiment. The sweep made no contact.

On 27 January tanks of the 2d and 3d Platoons of "A" Company fired 90mm HE H&I fires and 90mm HE at suspected enemy positions. The 1st Platoon of "C" Company participated in a cordon and search operation with elements of the 1st Battalion, 4th Marine Regiment. The search covered a previous NVA ambush site and yielded documents and blood stained clothing.

On 28 January C11 hit a mine while operating in the CamLo area. The crew suffered one WIA (non med-evac) and the tank suffered suspension system damage. Tanks of the 2d platoon, Company "C" fired 90mm HE at suspected enemy positions.

On 29 January a Company "C" tank fired at enemy positions near the Washout and destroyed one bunker.

On 30 January Company "C" tanks fired at enemy positions around the Washout and destroyed one bunker and one enemy flag and caused one secondary explosion. "A" Company tanks fired at suspected enemy positions with unknown results. A composite platoon from "B" and "C" Companies commanded by the "A" Company Executive Officer conducted a sweep on Route #9 from Dong Ha with elements of the 3d Battalion, 4th Marine Regiment. The tanks fired at suspected positions with unknown results.

On 31 January tanks of "A" Company at the Gio Linh and Washout positions fired 90mm HE at suspected enemy locations with unknown results. The Composite Platoon from "B" and "C" Companies went on a road sweep with elements of the 3d Battalion, 4th Marine Regiment. The tanks received 60mm mortar, recoilless rifle and small arms fire. C31 and B24 fired a total of 28 90mm HE at enemy positions resulting in two KIA (confirmed).

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Several weapons were also captured. At 0800 on 31 January the gun tanks from Battalion Headquarters and two flame tanks departed the Battalion Command Post enroute to Dong Ha via Hue. On Route #1 the unit was advised of heavy enemy activity toward Hue. The unit continued on and linked up with an infantry company also moving toward the city. In the vicinity of YD 7821 the tanks and infantry encountered another infantry unit which was engaged with the enemy. The combined force fought its way into the southern portion of the city in an effort to reach the LCU ramp. While enroute the unit was ordered to relieve the MACV Compound in Hue which was under siege. After eight hours of house to house street fighting the unit entered the MACV Compound and joined in its defense.

The Battalion Reconnaissance Squad continued its activity around the Battalion Command Post until 30 January. There were no contacts.

On 30 January 130 men from Headquarters and Service Company were joined into a Provisional Rifle Company and assigned to Quang Tri for defense of the cantonment which is under construction.

At 0400 on 31 January the Battalion Command Post underwent a mortar and rocket attack. No casualties were taken.

On 31 January the Battalion Commander displaced and established a tactical Command Post at Dong Ha.

Two in-country orientation briefings were held during the month for newly joined personnel. Two tank crewmen's courses were also conducted. A class on Communications Security was conducted by a representative from III MAF for all officers and SNCO's in the Battalion Command Post. Another representative from III MAF gave a class on narcotics for all officers and SNCO's of the Battalion CP.

On 22 January twenty-two maintenance personnel of the Battalion attended a class on the preservation of secondary repairable items.

100 seconds of flame were fired.

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On 31 January 1968, this command had a shortage of 22 major end items; ten M48A3 tanks, one M51 recovery vehicle, four M38A1 utility trucks, one M37B1 truck, one M49C refueler, one TD-15 tractor, one M54 truck and three mixing and transfer units. No major end items of equipment were received during this period. One M54 truck which hit a mine was declared a combat loss and dropped from the supply account. The following items were evacuated: three M54 trucks, fifteen M14 rifles, three AN/MRC-36 communication vehicles, four AN/PRC-10 radios, three AN/PRC-8 radios and two AN/GRC-3 radios.

The tank platoon for BLT 3/1, 9th MAB, was "chopped" to this battalion and redesignated as the 3d Platoon, Company "C". This platoon contained the following items: five M48A3 tanks, one M54 truck, one M38A1 utility truck, one M105A2 trailer and one M100 trailer. This platoon had no Xenon searchlights or FM series radios and only two modified commander's cupolas.

Primary supply activities during this period have revolved around the integration of records and material received from the 3d Anti-Tank Battalion, collation of all documents submitted prior to 15 September 1967 and preparations for displacement of the battalion headquarters. All correspondence, documents and stock received from the Anti-Tank Battalion have been merged with assets on hand. Shipment of all T/E items to Company "A", 3d Anti-Tanks has been completed. Most supply matters must be conducted by radio which has proved satisfactory thus far. Resupply is the paramount problem at Khe Sanh since combat and climatic conditions often adversely affect air delivery capabilities. Particular difficulties have been encountered in obtaining a wide range of individual equipment. Packing, crating and turning in of excess material has commenced in view of the planned relocation of the battalion to the Quang Tri area during February. Relocation of the battalion headquarters will improve supply response to the subordinate units. Overall response to priority O2 requisitions has remained slow with continuing message follow-up necessary in most cases. Fourteen items have been nominated for red ball action for periods ranging up to 60 days. Of these, only two items have been received. The cancellation and resubmission of all documents submitted prior to 15 September 1967 is still in progress. It has been necessary to reorder on a higher priority in many instances due to lost lead time.

The overall maintenance situation of this organization continues to remain satisfactory in spite of the wide separation

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of subordinate units. At the end of this reporting period there were 14 tracked vehicles, 23 motor transport vehicles and 2 ordnance items deadlined. Of these, 7 tanks and 15 motor transport vehicles were at third echelon maintenance facilities. The availability of first/second echelon tank repair parts has continued to show a slight improvement and organizational deadline has remained minimal. However, third echelon maintenance facilities simply do not have major items in the maintenance float assets which results in extended deadlined periods. The availability of repair parts or replacement infrared items remain in critically short supply and none have been received since the early portion of December 1967. The availability of motor transport parts required to remove vehicles from organizational deadline remains satisfactory. The third echelon deadline rate has continued to increase in quantity and time due to evacuation of vehicles to 3d FSR for repairs without issuing code letters. Relatively few maintenance problems have occurred thus far with the M50A1 Ontos. However, it is expected that maintenance problems will increase proportionally with operational hours due to a lack of second echelon parts on hand.

Services have remained satisfactory. The permanent showers have not been completed. The grease trap for the messhall has been completed and is functioning satisfactorily. The most significant problem continues to be a lack of electricity. The expansion of the Gia Le perimeter has been completed and new bunkers have been constructed.

The overall transportation situation has shown a slight improvement during this period due to an input of additional drivers. Transportation of repair parts and other supplies to the widely dispersed subordinate units has become exceedingly difficult, particularly for those heavy items unique to tracked vehicles. The infrequency of convoys and unpredictability of air shipment has often resulted in major items deadlined up to 7 days while awaiting transportation of repair parts.

There were a total of thirteen incidents of enemy mine, RPG or artillery damage during this period. A Company "B" M48A3 tank, USMC 202143 was hit by an RPG on 24 January 1968. It was repaired and restored to service on 26 January 1968. One 106mm rifle was damaged by shrapnel and evacuated on 27 January. A Company "C" M48A3 tank, USMC 201825 hit a mine on 28 January. The tank was repaired and restored to service on 30 January. An H&S Company M67A2 tank, USMC 211207 hit a mine, was hit by a mortar on the turret and received two RPG hits on 31 January. Field expedient repairs were accomplished and the tank remained operational. An H&S Company M48A3 tank, USMC 201969 was hit by two RPG's on 31 January. The tank is

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currently operational and upon completion of the Hue City combat operation necessary repairs will be made. Four M54 trucks belonging to Company "C" were damaged by mortar fire. Repairs are in progress.

During the month, the Motor Transport Platoon and organic company vehicles logged 13,698 miles, hauled 1069 short tons and hauled 2575 personnel.

There were 18 personnel who required medical evacuation during January 1968.

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DECLASSIFIEDCIVIL AFFAIRS

The Village Dispensary located in Loc Son was completed during the month of January. This was a long range project. Four Vietnamese civilians will be made available by the village for training. It is hoped that these four civilians will take over the dispensary under the Government Health Program.

The erection of a foot bridge between the Hamlets of Ha Chan was completed this month. Construction was completed by civilians and members of the local CAC Unit. The Battalion arranged for materials and supervision of construction.

A pagoda located in the Battalion's C.A.A.R was damaged by friendly fires, received the last of 85 bags of cement for repairs.

Increased enemy activity prior to TET worried the civilian population. Their attitude concerning their government has not been shaken.

The Battalion's civic action activities in Loc Son were terminated in mid-January because of the displacement of the Command.

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DECLASSIFIEDMEDICAL AND DENTAL

During the month of January 601 cases were treated at the aid station. This is a slight decrease over the previous month. No significant disease trends were established for the period of this report. Total immunizations given were 975, and all immunizations are current except for plague and flu which are presently unavailable.

Venereal disease has decreased; four cases were diagnosed and treated during the month of January. All were contacted out of country.

Hospital Corps personnel strength remains adequate.

Training of Marine and Hospital Corps personnel has been temporarily disrupted as a result of tactical assignments and the impending battalion displacement.

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During the month of January the Communications Platoon improved the communication capabilities of the tank companies, while maintaining excellent communications within the battalion. The 3d Engineer Battalion discontinued communications guard for the Gio Lo Combat Base causing the message center to make courier runs to Division. Personnel from the maintenance section modified all of the tanks of "A" Company with the new radios, and a contact team from "MSG-A" modified all the Company "A" 3d Anti-Tank Battalion vehicles with the new family of radios. The wire section installed a new "HOT-LINE" to the Phu Bai Vital Defense Area COC.

The Communications Officer and Electronics Maintenance Officer conducted inspections of all companies. All companies were found to be satisfactory. "C" Company was operating from an M107 trailer pending displacement of their Command Post. The Battalion Communications Chief performed thirteen days TAD at Yokosuka, Japan for the purpose of attending a communications/security crypto school. A crypto operations school will be held for all message center personnel in the near future. A communications security briefing was held for the Battalion, 98 personnel attended.

The audio accessory kit (MK-1039/G) for the GVC helmet, and insulating compound was put on order by the maintenance section.

As of the 25th of January the message center had processed 723 incoming and outgoing radio messages, 292 courier messages. This represents a 2.5 to 1 ratio of radio to courier traffic.

At the present time, due to the assignment of personnel to the Provisional Rifle Company, the communications platoon is operating with seven men. This includes the Communications Officer, Communications Chief, Message Center Chief, one technician, 1 wire man, and two radio men.
