NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. GENERAL OVERVIEW OF ACTIVITIES. During the month of November, the Third Force Reconnaissance Company continued its assigned mission of reconnaissance and surveillance of areas directed by Commanding General, Third Marine Amphibious Force. November activity was light due to the new Surveillance and Reconnaissance Center (SRC) at III MAF Headquarters being established and staffed. The SRC, located in DANANG, experienced considerable communications difficulties between their location and this Company in PHUBAI.
2. COMMAND RELATIONS. Relations between the Company and outside units were a major function of the Commanding Officer and the S-3. Liaison meetings and discussions with various Marine and Army working elements included XXIV Corps, 101st. Abn. Div., 2nd/17th. Cav., 101st. Abn. Div. and 85th Medical Evacuation Center. There were also contacts made with DONG DA Training Center and MACV Advisory Team Five for permission to parachute onto their area.
3. MISSIONS ASSIGNED. There were a variety of missions given to the Company during November. These included the reconnaissance and surveillance of various areas of interest, SCUBA missions and target acquisition.
4. INTELLIGENCE. The information gathered by reconnaissance patrols was turned in to the SRC at III MAF for processing.
5. OPERATIONS. Field operations conducted by the Company in November were the lowest level of effort on record.
6. RESULTS OF OPERATIONS. Operational patrolling during the reporting period totalled four (4) patrols with no sightings or contacts of any kind.

7. SUPPORTING ARMS. There were no live artillery missions fired for teams during the reporting period.
8. LOGISTICS. The Company's logistical support during November was a constantly improving situation in the way of necessary clothing and equipment. Vehicle parts posed certain problems and communications equipment was becoming critical in the area of handsets for the AN/PRC-25 field radio.
9. COMMUNICATIONS/ELECTRONICS. The internal communications equipment and its functioning for the Company proved to be a little less than ideal at extreme ranges.
10. EQUIPMENT. Items of equipment utilized by the Third Force Reconnaissance Company have proven to be adequate for the majority of the missions assigned.
11. CIVIC ACTION. The Company does not participate in the Civic Action Program. The primary mission precludes close contact with Vietnamese nationals.
12. PERSONNEL AND ADMINISTRATION. Personnel assignments within the Company are made by the Commanding Officer and the S-1. Normal company level administration is accomplished by the section under the Administrative Officer.
13. TRAINING. Training for personnel in the Company consists of three (3) categories; (ie) training conducted within the Company itself, training accomplished by Company personnel attending outside training within III MAF, and personnel attending a school out of the I Corps area or out of Vietnam. During the reporting period, two (2) enlisted Marines attended the MACV RECONDO School at NHA TRANG and three (3) enlisted Marines went to SCUBA School in the Phillipines.
14. OTHER ITEMS OF INTEREST OR HISTORICAL VALUE. The Third Force Reconnaissance Company qualified one (1) officer and eight (8) enlisted Marines for Vietnamese Parachutists' Insignia.

1. There has been several reports that units are moving to the border for retraining, resupply, and replacements for the Winter/Spring Campaign in the Spring of 70. Approx 20-30 personnel from each unit were left to maintain the base camps.
2. Requirements pertaining to storage areas. Must be placed in a dry area and within one $\frac{1}{2}$ hours walking distance from VC/NVA communication trails. Must not be stored near a large stream. Located at the foot of mountains with streams a reasonable distance away. Each storage should only be 20 minutes walking distance from each other and one $\frac{1}{2}$ hours walking distance from the main storage area. The discovery of one such cache may well indicate the presence of a series of similar caches at regular intervals within the general area.
3. Located to the west of the assigned AO is a large area of bunkers, tunnels, foxholes, trails, punji pits and man traps, graves, hootches, fences, trench lines, pagoda and buddha shrines. There is also a base camp loc vic grid ZC 168 791.
4. Loc vic grid ZC 185 799 is a 200 lb bomb (DUD).






