

PART II
NARRATIVE SUMMARY

The month of July saw intensified preparations for the movement of this unit from An Hoa to the Division Area, to commence sometime during the early part of August 1970. Sections have reviewed their personnel requirements and reduced their number of personnel, with further reductions contemplated during August 1970 allowable as a result of reduced sectional commitments with the movement of the company to the Division Area.

Headquarters Supply commenced to relocate certain supply items of a non-essential nature to a temporary storage area adjacent to the sight of the new area. This shall greatly aid in reducing the normal problems associated with moving of a unit on the scheduled date. Further it shall reduce the transportation requirement on the effective date of the move.

Two O141 clerks were joined in the HqCo office, one to replace a clerk that was reassigned within the company, and the other who was joined as files clerk to allow an inter-office transfer of assignments to allow the training of a unit diary clerk to replace one who will rotate during early August 1970.

The administrative effort of the company office during the first half of the month was directed towards correcting minor discrepancies noted during the Division Administrative Audit conducted on 17 June 1970.
