



PART II
NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. During this reporting period, 7th Motor Transport Battalion remained under the administrative control of the 1st Marine Division. Task Force X-Ray exercised operational control from 1 APRIL to 26 APRIL. On 26 APRIL operational control passed to 5th Marine Regiment. Operational control of Company "C", 1st Motor Transport Battalion, by 7th Motor Transport Battalion, continued during the period 1 APRIL to 18 APRIL. On 18 APRIL, Company "C", 1st Motor Transport Battalion returned to parent control.


2. During this period, 7th Motor Transport Battalion transported 6,155 troops and 2,091 tons of all classes of supplies in support of Operations Boone, Oregon, and Union. In addition, mobile support was provided for other every-day commitments.

3. The operational summary shown herein includes 7th Motor Transport Battalion only.

SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1. 1 April Second Lieutenant L. J. CASLEY assumed Command of Headquarters and Service Company Vice Second Lieutenant H. HARLAN.
2. 1-8 April In support of Operation Boone, 7th Motor Transport Battalion transported 290 troops with organic equipment, 5 tons Class I, 20 tons Class II, 25 tons Class III, 10 tons Class IV, and 104 tons Class V supplies.
3. 4 April Captain J. L. BARKER assumed Command of Company "C" Vice Captain T. O. PIPMAN.
4. 4 April Second Lieutenant G. T. STARKWATER assumed Command of Company Vice First Lieutenant M. W. NEILL.



5. 8 April Second Lieutenant G. S. ECKISSOCK assumed Command of Company "C" Vice Captain J. L. BARKER.
6. 8 April First Lieutenant C. D. PARKER assigned duties as Battalion S-4/S-5 Vice Captain D. J. CALLAGHAN.
7. 9-30 April In support of Operation Oregon, 7th Motor Transport Battalion hauled 4,940 troops, 115 tons Class I, 984 tons Class II, 18 tons Class IV, and 77 tons Class V supplies.
8. 10 April Five members of the Battalion were presented with Purple Heart Decorations by the Battalion Commander. The awards were for wounds received while members of a Rough Rider convoy from Chu Lai to Da Nang on 24 March 1967.
9. 10 April Operational control of Company "C", 1st Motor Transport Battalion was passed on to Commanding General 1st Marine Division (Rein), FMF.
10. 19 April Second Lieutenant B. T. HEIDTKE assigned duties as Battalion S-5 Vice First Lieutenant C. D. PARKER.
11. 20 April Memorial services were conducted at 7th Motor Transport Battalion for two members of the Battalion who were killed in action while on a Rough Rider convoy from Chu Lai to Da Nang on 24 March 1967.
12. 25-30 April In support of Operation Union, 7th Motor Transport Battalion hauled 925 troops, 126 tons Class I, 281 Class II, 42 tons Class III, 15 tons Class IV, and 279 tons Class V supplies.
13. 26 April 7th Motor Transport Battalion began operating under the operational control of 5th Marine Regiment.




