

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

The company continued support of Marine units in the Danang TAOR and the Republic of Korea Marines with POL products. The average issues of Bulk Ground Products is 150,000 gallons weekly.

Support of operation "Pipestone Canyon" commenced on 15 June and will continue for an indefinite period. Support is provided by helilifted collapsible drums into the operation area. Current daily usage for "Pipestone Canyon" is 2,000 gallons of diesel and 1,000 gallons of combat Mogas.

Reconstruction of the supply account and procurement of equipment destroyed by fire continued. The company remained in C-3 Forstat category due to lack of supplies. Appropriate MARES reports have been submitted including GA cards and NORS requisitions for critical items.
