## PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY1. PERSONNEL AND ADMINISTRATION

Personnel losses due to administrative reasons include 81 Marine enlisted and 5 Marine officers. In return, this organization received 65 Marine enlisted and 2 Marine officers. During the month of January, 58 Marine enlisted and 2 Marine officer promotions were effected.

2. ORGANIZATION AND OPERATIONS

Battery F continued to support Operation AUBURN from their position at AT 963609 till 031400H, at such time they displaced to their permanent base camp at AT 987645 at 031530H when Operation AUBURN terminated. At 041600H, elements of Headquarters Battery commenced the movement of personnel and equipment to HUE PHU BAI. Personnel and equipment was transported by overland convoy, sea, and helicopter until the move was completed at approximately 162330H. The Command Post was shifted to HUE PHU BAI (YD 888127) at 121200H. Battery B and Battery F were chopped to the 3d Battalion, 11th Marines at 121200H. On 17 Jan 1968, the Battalion (Battery D) continued to support the 5th Marines from the 1st Battalion, 5th Marines combat base at PHU LOC (ZC 015010), and the 2d Battalion, 5th Marines (Battery E) from their combat base at HUE PHU BAI. At 190700Z, the Battalion was chopped OPCON to the 1st Field Artillery Group. On 27 Jan 1968, elements of the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines arrived at HUE PHU BAI to release this organization for other operational commitments. On 30 Jan 1968, the Battalion took OPCON of 2 4.2" Mortars from the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines. On 31 Jan 1968, Headquarters Battery and Battery E displaced to ZD 020024 to support elements of the 2d Battalion, 5th Marines. During the month of January, the Battalion was credited with 44 confirmed enemy KIA, and ~~160 probable enemy KIA~~. 3. TRAINING
