





PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

On 19 April 1968 two (2) 155mm Self-Propelled howitzers were transported by sea to Battery L at Phu Bai to increase the T/E assets of that battery. Subsequent to the arrival of the above mentioned howitzers two 155mm towed howitzers from the Second Provisional 155mm Howitzer Battery displaced from Battery L at Phu Bai to Battery M's position at AT 921717 and assumed the name of Battery M-X.

On 21 April 1968 Battery M-X displaced and occupied a position at grid AT 990717 relieving two Battery M 155mm Self Propelled Howitzers which returned to their parent unit at grid AT 921717. This move was initiated primarily due to the advantage of more firm ground in the new towed position which better supported the emplacement and employment of these weapons than the sandy area in which they were previously located.

On 23 April 1968 2nd Battalion, 13th Marines relieved 4th Battalion, 11th Marines of responsibility for manning OP TIGER. On the same date 4th Battalion, 11th Marines initiated providing one enlisted FO, one BC scope, and one radio in support of the 1st ALVT Company who man OP HAWK.

On 29 April 1968 Battery K assumed modified General Support/Reinforcing 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines (priority of fires to 3/11 except during rocket attacks) in support of Operation BALLARD VALLEY. Battery K performed the mission from its primary battery position at grid AT 879579.

(1) During the month of April there has been a slight decrease in guerilla activity in the Southern Danang T&OR. An increase in conventional warfare activity by the enemy was apparent.

(1) Units of this Battalion participated in one (1) operation during the month of April.

(a) Operation BALLARD VALLEY commenced 29 April. After Action report to follow upon completion of operation in May.

i. Training

(1) General Military Subjects training and certain technical training has been conducted in the Battalion with the goal of increasing combat efficiency.

(2) Renewed emphasis has been placed on weapon safety procedures and passive defense against chemical attack.

j. Logistics, Equipment and Supply

(1) Approximately 89% of 21,815 requisitions have been filled since arrival in Vietnam. 19,409 requisitions are completed.

(2) The current deadline status of motor transport equipment is 24%. There are 6 vehicles down for 2nd echelon maintenance and 16 down for 3rd echelon maintenance.

k. Civic Action/Civil Affairs

(1) Construction of a new school house in the hamlet of Phu Hoa was 95% completed during the month. Projected plans for a maternity Infirmary Dispensary were completed and submitted through the normal military and civilian channels for approval. Medcaps were conducted on a weekly basis.

l. Psychological Operations

(1) Leaflets were distributed to the people of Phu Hoa hamlet during Medcaps. Bulletin boards which had been constructed earlier were repaired and used to post leaflets and newspapers.
