NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of October the Battalion continued to execute its assigned mission of defending the KHE SANH Combat Base complex, maintaining security of Route 9 in the assigned operating area, maintaining, on a continual basis, a SPARROW HAWK platoon and conducting extensive reconnaissance and combat operations throughout the assigned operating area. In the execution of the assigned mission, the Battalion conducted two company size search and destroy operations, one SPARROW HAWK operation, ninety-four night ambushes, seventeen company (-) size patrols, fifty-four platoon size patrols and ninety-eight squad size patrols as well as establishing a total of two hundred fifty-three listening posts during the period.

Operation ARDMORE was terminated on 312359H October.

HIGHLIGHTS

On 10 October a contact team from the 15th IIT provided instruction for unit commanders on prisoner of war handling procedures, the mission and functions of IIT and the intelligence value of prisoners of war.

During the period 25-29 October the Division Personnel Response contact team instructed members of the Battalion in the varied facets of the Personal Response program.

PART IIISEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS1. Combat mission assigned.

- a. Occupy and defend Hills 861S and 861.
- b. Provide security forces as directed for the defense of the communications facility on Hill 950.
- c. Conduct extensive patrolling to detect and destroy enemy personnel infiltrating into and through the KHE SANH TAOR.
- d. Maintain one company as Regimental reserve. Designate one platoon as a "Sparrow Hawk" reaction force.
- e. Be prepared to execute contingency plans for the relief/reinforcement of LANG VEI, Combined Action Platoons 1 and 2 and the HUONG HOA District Headquarters at KHE SANH.
- f. Provide perimeter security and coordination for the defense of the KHE SANH Combat Base as directed.
- g. Be prepared to provide convoy security and such other security forces as may be directed.

2. Significant operations conducted.

- a. The Battalion participated in Operation ARDMORE during the entire month. Operation ARDMORE terminated at 312359H October.
- b. Company A relieved Company B and occupied the Battalion's assigned defensive sectors of the KHE SANH Combat Base on 2 October.
- c. On 4 October Company B conducted a search and destroy mission along National Route 9 to the Bridge site at XD 914403 and returned to the KHE SANH Combat Base along the RIVIERE DE RAO QUAN in order to develop a fordability study.
- d. Company B conducted a two day search and destroy operation in grid squares XD 8243, XD 8342, XD 8343 on 16 and 17 October.
- e. On 23 October the 3d Platoon of Company A was committed to support Reconnaissance Team 3B1. No contact was made.
- f. On 24 October the 3d Platoon of Company D relieved the 1st Platoon of Company B on Hill 950.

g. Company B relieved Company D on Hill 881S on 25 October.

h. On 28-29 October, 1st Platoon (Rein), Company D, conducted a two day sweep on the road from KHE SANH Combat Base to the bridge site in the vicinity of XD 810403.

i. On 29 October, Reconnaissance Team 2B3 became engaged with a force of twenty to twenty-five NVA at XD 803458 and requested assistance. The 2d Platoon (Rein), Company A, and the Company A Command Group were heli-lifted to Hill 861 enabling Company C (-) to leave Hill 861 and proceed to the contact area. While proceeding to the reconnaissance team's position, Company C (-) received one incoming 60mm mortar dud from the vicinity of XD 804454. Company C (-) linked up with the reconnaissance team and escorted them back to Hill 861. The reconnaissance team claimed four NVA KIA (Confirmed). There were no friendly casualties.

3. Casualties inflicted upon the enemy.

a. Personnel: None.

b. Weapons captured: None.

4. Casualties sustained. There was one KIA during the month on 13 October while on a night ambush in close proximity to the enemy.

5. New techniques employed. Nothing significant.

6. Command relations. The 26th Marine Regiment exercised Operational Control of the Battalion while Administrative Control was maintained by 3d Marine Division.

7. Equipment. Nothing significant.

8. Logistics.

a. The companies were supplied with 828,236 pounds of supplies by R-34 and H-53 aircraft. The Battalion's vehicles traveled 4,136 miles in support of the Battalion.

b. During the month this Battalion received poncho liners, water-proof tape, knee length rubber boots, space heaters and tents in partial fulfillment of the Battalion's monsoon requirements.

c. Development in the KHE SANH cantonment included improvement and enlargement of the enlisted club; erection of a five hundred man tent-type field mess, and construction of additional living bunkers.

d. Improvements to positions on Hills 861, 881S and 950 continued.

9. Civic action.

a. During the month of October, visits were made to the surrounding

villages for the purpose of liaison with village chiefs.

b. MEDCAPS were made to KHE SANH and the surrounding villages on a regular schedule. The area visited by the MEDCAP team was enlarged to include two additional villages and a total of 4 visitations centers. Soap was made available for distribution by the MEDCAP team in an effort to aid the populace in hygiene. A total of seven hundred eighteen VIETNAMESE and BRU Montagnards received medical treatment during the month.

#### 10. Administration.

a. Company rears were maintained at the Battalion CP to provide administrative support for the deployed companies.

b. The latest available statistics indicate that the Battalion has a unit diary error rate of 0.9%.

#### 11. Personnel.

##### a. Losses:

(1) Four Marine officers transferred for duty to other WESTPAC Commands and one officer rotated to CONUS.

(2) Eleven Marine enlisted transferred for duty to WESTPAC Commands, one hundred fifty-four enlisted transferred to CONUS, and eight enlisted transferred by service records.

(3) There were no USN officers transferred.

(4) Nine USN enlisted were transferred for duty.

##### b. Joinings:

(1) Eleven Marine officers joined for duty.

(2) One hundred seventy-one Marine enlisted and ten USN enlisted joined for duty.

c. During the month of October eighty-two men from the Battalion went on R&R and two men were granted emergency leave.

#### 12. Intelligence.

a. Enemy activity. Enemy activity for the month of October was light. Numerous bunker complexes were found, most appeared to have been constructed three to four months ago. The following significant incidents occurred:

(1) At 300950H, at XD 809459, Company C observed three enemy wearing what appeared to be gray uniforms. An 81mm mortar mission was

called and twelve rounds HE and two WP were fired. The area was searched at the completion of the fire mission with negative results.

(2) At 301430H, at XD 777438, Company B received small arms fire from the vicinity of XD 773427. Scout Snipers and 60mm Mortars fired on the suspected enemy position. The area was searched with negative results.

(3) At 311250H, an artillery FO on Hill 950 spotted two figures at XD 850472. A 105mm fire mission was requested. Twelve rounds were fired with good target coverage, with unknown results.

13. Informational services. During the month of October there were one hundred eighty-five individual news releases distributed to the Fleet Home Town News Services.

14. Communications. Nothing significant.

15. Weather.

16. Fire support and fire support coordination. During the month of October artillery units in general support of the Battalion provided the normal types of fire support missions. Artillery fired twenty-eight observed fire missions and eight hundred thirteen H&I missions in direct support of the Battalion. The 81mm Mortar Platoon fired sixty observed fire missions during the month.

17. Air support.

a. During this period the Battalion maintained a Forward Air Control team on Hill 881S and on 30 October a team was sent to Hill 861 in support of Company A. The team on Hill 861 was recalled to KHE SANH Combat Base on 31 October. During the month there were no fixed wing missions controlled by the teams.

b. Four hundred nineteen tons of supplies were lifted by helicopter to the companies on Hill 881S and 861 and to other deployed units during this period.

c. Seven MEDEVAC missions were coordinated and controlled by the

Air Liaison team and the Forward Air Control team during the month of October.

18. Medical. During the month of October, nine hundred seventy-six Marines were seen at routine sick call. No significant trend in ailments was noted. The Command continued to stress maximum anti-malaria measures. One thousand one hundred fifty-seven immunizations were administered during the reporting period.

19. Chaplain and moral welfare. During the month of October a total of thirty-five worship services were conducted. Roman Catholic Masses were celebrated for the Battalion by the 2d Battalion, 4th Marines Chaplain during the first two weeks of October. Four troop indoctrination lectures were held for a total of one hundred eighty-one new Marines and Corpsmen. Tract-racks were placed in the Battalion mess halls and the Battalion Aid Station. Twenty cartons of religious literature from the Lutheran Council in the USA together with Bibles have been placed in these racks. The Battalion Chaplain continued to maintain close contact with local missionaries.

20. Personnel and morale services.

a. Postal. Battalion mail personnel handled approximately eight bags of mail per day. This included packages, letters, newspapers and magazines for members of this Command.

b. Special services. On 19 October the Battalion received a Division Special Services shipment that included six hundred paper back books, four hundred pairs of socks and assorted games. These items were issued to Battalion personnel and attached units. On 21 October a shipment of green sweatshirts were received from Division Special Services and were delivered to the companies for issue to each man.

c. Decorations and awards. The following decorations and awards were awarded to personnel of the Battalion during the month of October.

(1) Two Marine enlisted were awarded the Bronze Star Medal.


(2) Two Marine enlisted were awarded the Navy Commendation Medal.

21. Training.

a. During the month of October one hundred eighty-one enlisted personnel and eleven officers were given a three day orientation and training program prior to being assigned to the companies.

b. On-the-job training was conducted for all MOSs. Seventy personnel were trained in the care, operation and functioning of the .50 caliber machine gun.



1. SUMMARY OF ENEMY SITUATION.

a. Most of the information available about enemy activities in the AO has been supplied by reconnaissance units operating in the southeast sector of the AO. There is a definite lack of knowledge covering enemy activities in the northwest sector.

b. The road system from the KHE SANH Combat Base to the temporary bridge site at XD 912403 offers a considerable number of potential ambush sites, particularly from the northern side of National Route 9. The enemy has the capability to interdict the highway with up to a battalion size force. Though road mining has not been used extensively in our TAOR, the potential threat of enemy laid mines should not be discounted.

c. A recon team operating in the southeastern sector of the AO from 20 - 23 September revealed the following information:

(1) There is possible VC activity in the area of LANG KAT I (XD 904394) and LANG KAT II (XD 909395). The extent is not known, though an earlier agent report of 10 September indicated an NVA/VC Company operating south of National Route 9 in this general area.

(2) Brou fishermen have been seen fishing at various places along the Rao Quan River.

(3) The village of LANG KHOAI I at XD 875406 is not occupied.

d. The northeastern side of the Rao Quan River is characterized by high, dominating terrain features that offer excellent observation of the river. On the 2nd of September, a recon team operating in GS 9142 made contact with 60-70 NVA, and had to be hastily extracted. The enemy has the capability of moving along the high ground northeast of the river with up to a company size force.

2. ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS OF INFORMATION.

a. Determine if enemy forces are presently operating along the Rao Quan River. If so, in what strength? \_\_\_\_\_

b. Determine if it appears that the enemy is using the low ground along the river in which to move his forces or establish base camps. If harbor sites are discovered, how are they oriented? Do they appear to be semi-permanent or merely temporary lay over positions?

c. Determine possible fording sites across the Rao Quan River that can be used during the present water level stage. At any given crossing, what is the depth of the water, and its swiftness? What is the texture and firmness of the river bed? How much will the water level have to rise before these fording sites become nonpassable?





2. MISSION. To provide one reinforced rifle company as a ground reaction force to conduct spoiling attack or reinforce the beleaguered CAPs 1 and 2 and HUONG HOA District Headquarters at KHE SANH should they be threatened by or come under enemy attack.

3. EXECUTION.

a. Concept of Operations. On order, one reinforced rifle company will be dispatched by air or surface means to provide relief for CAPs 1 and 2 and HUONG HOA District Headquarters. An additional reinforced company and Battalion Command Group will be deployed on order. The Battalion Command Group will assume OpCon of all ground units in the vicinity of District Headquarters.

b. Company (Rein), 1st Battalion, 26th Marines. Be prepared on order to move by assigned mode of transportation or foot march to District Headquarters as a ground reaction force to conduct spoiling attack or reinforce the attack area.

c. Battalion Reserve. Company (Rein), 1st Battalion, 26th Marines. Be prepared on order for deployment in the zone of action.

d. Coordinating Instructions.

(1) This plan effective for planning upon receipt and execution on order.

(2) Primary means of transit to Zone of Action will be helicopter; alternate means will be truck convoy or infantry column.

(3) The assembly area for the ground reaction force and supporting elements, should mode of transportation be truck convoy, is the road adjacent to main gate.

(4) The committed reinforced rifle company commander is designated as the Convoy Commander and is in charge of all supporting elements should mode of transportation be truck convoy.

(5) Friendly forces will exercise care to avoid injury to innocent civilians; however, this precaution in no way precludes the return of hostile fire. See reference (c).

(6) Commanding Officer, 1st Battalion, 13th Marines will provide sufficient number of M-35 trucks to transport the ground reaction force to the zone of action, should mode of transportation be truck convoy.

(7) For planning purposes, helo teams will consist of 4 men for each CH-34 helicopter and truck teams will consist of 20 men for each M-35 truck.

(8) Primary LZ is HUMMINGBIRD and BLUEBIRD and alternate is LZ HAWK.

(9) Armed UH1E Helicopters will provide air cover to the convoy enroute if truck transportation is utilized during daylight hours.

(10) Utilize supporting arms to the utmost during movements, with particular emphasis to suspected ambush sites.

(11) If mode of transportation is vehicles, the M-42 will lead the column and the M-55 will provide security to the rear of the column.

(12) Unit Commander will report to this headquarters as column uncovers the designated check points when assigned.


