



PART II
NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of July this battalion was involved in Operation MAMELUKE THRUUST, PHASE II and III. Phase II was conducted in the high jungle canopy within the Happy Valley Complex, southwest of Danang; Phase III was conducted in the Antenna Valley region, southwest of An Hoa Combat/Fire Support Base. Both operations were conducted in extremely difficult terrain. Contact was minimal, however, numerous harbor sites, caches and other evidence of recent occupation by NVA/VC units were discovered. On 22 July the entire battalion was lifted by fixed wing aircraft to Phu Bai and on the 25th of July, assumed responsibility and control of the Northern Task Force X-Ray area of operations.

SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS.

1. COMBAT MISSIONS ASSIGNED

- a. Conduct search and destroy operations in the Happy Valley Complex in support of Operation MAMELUKE THRUST, PHASE II.
- b. Conduct search and destroy operations in the Antenna Valley Region, southwest of An Hoa Fire Support Base, in support of Operation MAMELUKE THRUST, PHASE III.
- c. Conduct security patrols, killer ambushes and occupy road and bridge positions along National route #1 as security.
- d. Conduct joint operations with RP/PP units in the Phu Bai AO.
- e. Maintain one company Bald Eagle Force for employment anywhere in the Task Force X-Ray AO.
- f. Be prepared to provide relief/reaction forces for the Thon Ton Katt Refugee Village.
- g. Be prepared to provide relief/reaction forces for all CAP units in AO, to include Vin Loc District Headquarters.

2. SIGNIFICANT OPERATIONS CONDUCTED.

- a. From 1 July until 3 July the battalion continued offensive operations in the Thong Duc/Happy Valley Complex. On 3 July the unit was lifted from Thong Duc to An Hoa to prepare for operations southwest of the An Hoa Fire Support Base.
- b. From 4 July until 7 July the battalion was resupplied and refurbished at An Hoa.
- c. On 8 July the battalion was helilifted from An Hoa to LZ Hawk (Vic ZC 215370). From that time until 20 July, 1st Battalion, 26th Marines conducted Battalion/Company sized search and destroy operations within assigned AO. During this period this unit was involved in three (3) battalion sized helicopter assaults.
- d. On the 21st of July Company C was alerted and moved by helicopter to exploit a Recon team sighting of 20 NVA/VC. Brief contact was made resulting in one NVA/VC KIA and 55 civilian refugees were lifted out of the zone when Company C was extracted late in the afternoon of the 21st.
- e. On 20 July the battalion was helilifted to An Hoa and began preparations for fixed wing air lift to Phu Bai and further, began initial planning to assume control and responsibility for the Northern Task Force X-Ray AO.

5. NEW TECHNIQUES EMPLOYED. None.

6. COMMAND RELATIONS. The 3rd Marine Division continued to exercise administrative control for the entire period. The 26th Marine Regiment exercised operational control from 1 July to 31 July 1968.

7. EQUIPMENT. The shortage of major items of equipment such as truck, platform M-274A2 and trailer, water M-107A1 did not effect the operational capability of the battalion during the month of July. During the two brief periods of rest and refurbishing conducted for this battalion, all weapons and radios were technically inspected.

8. LOGISTICS. During the month of July the supply situation was adequate. Normal shortages were experienced. However, no shortages were extensive enough to effect the operational capability of the battalion or subordinate units.

9. CIVIC ACTION. During the period 8 July to 20 July this battalion conducted search and clear missions in close proximity to several inhabited villages. Interrogation of villagers indicated that this was the first time in two or three years that friendly forces and GVN had been in the area. Medcaps, redistribution of food stuffs and kind treatment enabled this battalion to establish mutually beneficial relations and enabled this unit to obtain valuable intelligence information.

10. ADMINISTRATION. Battalion and Company admin rears continued to support the battalion from Quang Tri. The distance between the tactical and administrative units continues to work hardships on individual Marines and the battalion, particularly in important administrative matters.

12. INTELLIGENCE.

a. Summary of known enemy activity

(1) During the month of July the battalion spent the first half of the month on Operation MAMELUKE THRUST/IOCAHONTAS FOREST. The enemy avoided contact. Instances of contact were usually confined to point men only. Several instances of sniper fire occurred however, there was no sustained attack.

(2) Enemy fortifications consisted mainly of spider holes and other similar type fighting positions. There was no evidence of bunkers, although it is believed that the enemy occupied the living bunkers found in the abandoned villages.

(3) No instances of enemy use of large caliber offensive weapons were reported.

(4) In the new area of operations there have been no instances of rocket, artillery or mortar fire. Only small arms fire has been received and it appeared to be of a harassing nature.

(5) No substantial contact has been made and sniper fire is at a minimum. The enemy generally confined his movement to the hours of darkness. Terrain features of the new AO are as follows:

- (a) The Troui Mountain Range
- (b) Hills 133 and a smaller hill located at (YD 864004).
- (c) The Bach Ma Road and Route #1.

14. COMMUNICATION. Communications problems were minimal during the month, except when operating in the high jungle canopy. The use of 292 Antenna was mandatory.
15. WEATHER. The month of July was generally clear with late afternoon and early evening showers and thunder storms. At no time during the month did the weather seriously restrict the operational capability of the battalion.
16. FIRE SUPPORT AND FIRE SUPPORT COORDINATION. During the month of July the artillery units in direct and general support provided excellent target coverage.
17. AIR SUPPORT. During July the battalion employed both fixed wing and helicopter support within the operational areas. The battalion conducted three offensive helicopter assault landings and one fixed wing lift of the entire battalion from An Hoa Fire Support Base to Phu Bai Combat Base. All aircraft employment and utilization were smooth and efficient.
18. MEDICAL. During the month of July 503 Marines were treated at the Battalion Aid Station. Of these none were wounded by hostile action. No Marine required evacuation. There were 3 non-battle injuries, none of which required evacuation. The total immunizations for the month numbered 13.
19. CHAPLAIN AND MORAL WELFARE. The battalion did not have a Chaplain for the entire month. Chaplain KELLY was wounded in action on 13 June and evacuated. Services were conducted, when time allowed, by visiting Chaplains from other units.
20. MORALE AND PERSONNEL SERVICES.
- a. Postal Services - Mail for members of this battalion was received daily during the month of July, except for the 22nd. A total of 236 bags of mail were distributed.


