Subj: Command Chronology; period of December 1965

(1) On 18 December, over 700 orphans representing 13 orphanages from the Iwakuni area were hosted by the MCAS and tenant units of the Marine Corps and Navy to a gigantic Christmas party. The orphans, some blind or deaf started arriving at 11:15 AM by bus. The children from a nearby island orphanage were transported by boat. A treat of chicken legs with all the trimmings was waiting at mess halls at mainside and wingside. Following the meal, the children, accompanied by an adopted "Father for a Day," toured the base activities including static displays of the flight line and in the hangars. A two-hour show of Japanese cartoons, music and community singing preceded the visit of Santa Claus. Christmas gifts were presented to each child, the buses were then reloaded with children, gifts and packages of fruit, nuts and candy for the return trip to the orphanages.

(2) Fifty-five members of the 200 plus voice Doshisha Choir, from Kyoto, Japan presented a program 19 December, of Christmas and religious music at the station theater.

(3) Representatives of the Iwakuni industries and city government toured the air station 20 December. Briefings were conducted by Colonel McDANIEL, Colonel HOWE, Colonel MIYAMOTO and Captain MINOR. The necessity of high noise level as it compares to safety was discussed at length. The flight lines of MAG-13 and JASDF were visited and functions of the aircraft were explained. A demonstration of high performance takeoff, MOREST landing and other functions of the flight line were witnessed with interest by the tourees.

(4) On 21 December, a dependent children's party was held at the mainside Enlisted Club. Approximately 300 dependent children and 30 Japanese children attended. The event was sponsored by the Enlisted Club, NCO Club, Officers Club, Enlisted Wives Club and the Officers Wives Club.
