

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. Special Operations:

a. During May 1968, VMO-2 flew a total of 3538 sorties for a total of 1294.6 hours. This total includes both gunships and slicks. During these combat sorties, the pilots accomplished the following tasks:

- (1) Armed Helo Escort
- (2) Visual Reconnaissance
- (3) Fire Fly
- (4) TAC(A)
- (5) VIP
- (6) APD (Airborne Personnel Detection)

2. Highlights of the month. The following data is taken from the daily after action reports and is typical of the kind of operations that were performed by VMO-2 during May 1968.

- 1 May While escorting HMM-361 on Med Evac Mission H-5G, Starch Med Evac A/C crashed after picking up the emergency Med Evac. The VMO-2 A/C loaded and picked up the emergency and carried it to the hospital. Returned to crash site and escorted the pick up A/C back to MMAF.
- 3 May Two VMO-2 gunships launched on emergency Quick Reaction Mission H-4, to conduct fire support. Later joined by a third gunship, the gunships accounted for 14 confirmed KBA.
- 11 May Two gunships while on Mission H-19 received and returned fire. Total BDA for mission was 8 structures damaged.
- 12 May One gunship while flying Med Evac Escort Mission H-51, received and returned fire with a BDA of 1 confirmed and 3 possible KBA.
- 22 May One VMO-2 gunship while escorting HMM-265 on mission H-18, received and returned fire, with a BDA of 6 confirmed KBA, and 1 possible KBA.
- 23 May Two VMO-2 gunships on mission H-19, received and returned fire, with a BDA of 1 confirmed KBA and 2 possible KBA.
- 27 May Two VMO-2 gunships in support of Operation Allenbrook, directed Artillery fire on a hooch, damaging same. They also engaged a sampan and accounted for 3 confirmed KBA.
