NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. Special Operations:

a. During November 1968, Marine Observation Squadron 2 flew a total of 2242 sorties for a total of 1847.3 hours. The following tasks were accomplished:

- (1) Armed Helo Escort
- (2) Visual Reconnaissance
- (3) TAC(A) (Tactical Air Controller Airborne)
- (4) Artillery Spot
- (5) Command and Control
- (6) Photo Reconnaissance
- (7) VIP
- (8) APD (Airborne Personnel Detection)
- (9) Fire Fly

2. Highlights of the month. The following data is taken from the daily sitreps.

- 5 Nov Two UH-1E's recieved fire at AT 870890. They were in escort of two CH-46's. The weather at the scene was below minimims. Finally, after numerous passes through clouds, one CH-46 was guided into the zone. The other CH-46 and the UH-1E's recieved fire, constant suppressive fire was laid down by the UH-1E's. The airborne CH-46 recieved numerous hits, wounding one of its crew members. The mission had to be aborted. Ref. Part IV daily sitreps.
- 16 Nov One UH-1E while flying on a Quick Reaction recieved and returned fire at AT 960691 and recieved 3 confirmed KBA at AT 961961. Ref. Part IV daily sitreps.
- 17 Nov One OV-10A while on VR of AT 9468 for 1/7, enemy contact at AT 946694. Covered Med Evac Helo at AT 946697. Three confirmed KBA by UH-1E'S at AT 960691. Rocket's and rocket sites observed at AT 961961- Reaction force inserted. Ref. Part IV daily sitreps.
