**PART TWO - Narrative Summary**

1. Operations and events of MWSG-17 were of a routine nature during the month of January.
2. The SOAP Lab analyzed a total of 1,933 special oil samples and the results were returned to the squadrons concerned, even though the Lab was down during the month due to shortage of disc-electrodes.
3. During the month of January, Aircraft Staging received a total of 10 aircraft and transferred a total of 16 aircraft.
4. During the month of January WERS-17 Motor Transport Section was employed in (2) two Rough Rider Convoys supporting MAG-16 redeployment from Phu Bai to Danang.
