## PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

Marine Wing Support Group 17 and subordinate units provided general support to the 1st Marine Aircraft Wing during the period 1 - 31 October 1972.

For CATEGORY THREE from 1 - 31 October 1972, the following support was provided for the organizations indicated.

Personnel. Marine Wing Support Group 17 provided 3 Officers and 43 Enlisted in support of Task Force Delta, 3 Officers and 17 Enlisted in support of MAG-12, 7 Enlisted for guard duty at MAG-12, 7 Enlisted in support of MAG-36, 2 Enlisted assigned TAD to NAS Cubi Point, 1 Enlisted assigned TAD to NB Subic Bay, and 2 Enlisted in support of MWHS-1.

Operations. No aircraft support was provided during this reporting period to units involved in Vietnam Operations. During this reporting period H&MS-17 flew a total of 252.8 hours. Breaking this figure down, 190.2 hours were flown in support of 1st MAW commitments, Training of new pilots and crewmembers utilized 58.2 hours and testing of aircraft used 4.4 hours. The daily availability averaged approximately 55% or 3.7 aircraft.

Logistics. Wing Equipment and Repair Squadron 17 provided 4136 man hours and 178,430 gallons of JP-5 from TAFDS in support of MAG-12 and MAG-15 (Rear) operations. On 24 October 1972 fueling operations were terminated. An additional 8 man hours and 48 operation hours were provided MAG-12 and 20 man hours and 16 operation hours to MAG-15 including equipment operations and after hours support, such as dispatching and 2d echelon maintenance connected with continuous operations.

Supply. Marine Wing Support Group 17 Supply Department provided the following material and manpower support to MAG-15 as listed below.
