PART II

Narrative Summary

Marine Air Control Group 18 continued to operate Air Control, Anti-Air Warfare and Air Support Facilities in support of the 1st Marine Aircraft Wing. Throughout the reporting period Marine Air Control Group 18 provided continuing support to the 7th Fleet in the form of Air Intercept Controllers from Marine Air Control Squadron 4. A TDCC Detachment from Marine Air Control Squadron 4 has been in operation to augment the data link exchange between United States Air Force and United States Navy units during the same period as well.

Marine Wing Communications Squadron 18 during the subject period provided personnel and equipment to RVN in support of 1st Marine Aircraft Wing units there on deployment.

During latter April, 1972, Marine Air Control Group 18 participated in the 1st Marine Aircraft Wing Change of Command Ceremonies, seeing MAJOR GENERAL L. E. BROWN assuming command from MAJOR GENERAL R. G. OWENS, Jr..

Commencing mid May this command was alerted to the possibility of providing a communication package (MWCS 18) and a surveillance radar/TADC package (MACS 4) to operate from an advance base. Approximately 26 May 1972 these packages were completed and standing by. On 28 May 1972 1st Marine Aircraft Wing OpOrd 1-72 (S) was received, tasking this command to form a MACG 18 Det. for support of Task Force Delta. MACG 18 Det, 79.3.9.4 (Major J. C. BEVER) was established and activated, in place NAM PHONG, on 30 May 1972. Movement of personnel and equipment commenced on 26 May 1972. In addition a 2nd ASRT (MASS 2) was on call for possible deployment to RVN.

Subsequently, on 19 June 1972 it was determined that no requirement existed for operation of the Marine Air Control Squadron 4 detachment at NAM PHONG, Thailand, and orders were issued for retro-grade of all personnel and equipment except that necessary to support the AN/TYA-11. Retro-grade movement to Okinawa was accomplished by 22 June 1972.
