II. Narrative

The UH-34D's assigned to Headquarters and Maintenance Squadron 36 flew a total of 55.3 hours during December 1966.

The Headquarters and Maintenance Squadron 36 C-117D flew 9 flare drops and dropped 507 flares. There flare drops logged 34.7 flight hours. The C-117D flew one medical evacuation from Chu Lai to DaNang logging 1.3 hours. On 25 December 1966, LtCol's CARLSON and GARROTTO flew the Johnny Grant USO show from Phu Bai to DaNang in the C-117D.
