1. Organizational Data:

a. Sub Unit #1, Marine Air Base Squadron 36, Marine Aircraft Group 36, 1st Marine Aircraft Wing was formed on 2 February 1968 at Marine Quang Tri Airfield, RVN to provide administrative control and services to the personnel of Marine Aircraft Group 36 who are providing services to the tactical elements located at Quang Tri, Dong Ha, and Khe Sanh.

b. Period covered by this report: 2-29Feb68.

c. Officer-in-Charge Sub Unit #1: Chief Warrant Officer-3 Edwin R. VAUGHN USMC 2-29Feb68.

d. Average monthly strength: Marine Corps 12 Officers, 215 Enlisted; Navy; 1 Officer and 9 enlisted.

2. Significant Events:

a. 2 February 1968: CWO-3 E. R. VAUGHN and 3 enlisted established the Sub Unit and submitted the first Unit Diary.

b. 16 February 1968: 1 Officer and 191 enlisted personnel were joined from Marine Air Base Squadron 36.

c. 19 February 1968: 8 Officers and 21 enlisted personnel were joined from Headquarters and Maintenance Squadron 36.

d. 27 February 1968: Colonel J. E. HANSEN, USMC, reported aboard from MWSG-17 for duty as Deputy Commander, MAG-36 (Fwd), vice Colonel O. V. GALLENINE, USMC, detached.

3. General.

a. During February 1968, Food Services fed an average of 1175 men per meal. An outstanding accomplishment in a mess hall designed to accommodate 200 men per meal.

b. TAFDS dispensed 62,757 gallons of aviation gas and 266,029 gallons of P-4 Jet fuel.

c. Utilities provided the normal base services and especially noteworthy is the 480,000 gallons of pure water furnished to MAG-36 and neighboring supporting elements.
