The month of March was another month of excellence for the pilots and men of HML-167 in many fields. A great effort was required by all and all gave willingly as the Squadron accumulated 1521.6 hours of flight time.

Squadron Gunships were very busy compiling an impressive 778.0 hours of flight time. The gunships expended 102,800 rounds of 7.62 mm, 1,876 2.75 inch rockets, and 24 Helicopter Trap Weapons. In total the Squadron dropped 34.14 tons of ordnance in the accomplishment of its missions. Gunships were provided for a variety of missions including escort for medical evacuations, insertions and extractions of reconnaissance teams, resupply and the airborne personnel detector missions.

Squadron slicks also achieved an enviable record. In the course of providing invaluable assistance to Marine Ground Commanders the slicks flew 743.6 hours. The adaptability and flexibility of the UH-1E is illustrated vividly in the many and varied mission accomplished by the slicks. In addition to providing transportation for many VIP's, the slicks were called upon to provide airborne visual reconnaissance and command and control aircraft. HML-167 flew 5 airborne personnel detector missions. Among the 2736 passengers carried, some of the most eminent were Secretary of Defense LAIRD and Lieutenant Generals' CUSHMAN and NICKERSON.

Being always alert the Squadron's gunships and slicks picked up 19 medical evacuations when the regular medical evacuation helicopter was full, busy elsewhere, or when emergency situations arose making immediate action necessary.

The Squadron flew in support of Operations "Taylor Common", and "Victory Dragon IX", The Squadron participated in the initiation of "Oklahoma Hills" and in so doing employed 24 helicopter trap weapons to clear Robin the initial Landing Zone for the operation.

March was also a good month for the people behind the scenes, the people whose hard work made the achievements possible. The Squadron's average availability of 83.5% for the month of March is compared to the Wing average of 55-60%. Marine Light Helicopter Squadron 167's professionalism and desire to excel can only bring greater accolades in the future.
