

(U) William E. Dayhoff, Special Agent, Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), San Diego Field Division, was interviewed by professional staffers Hyon Kim, Michael Jacobson and Quinn John Tamm, Jr., on November 17, 2003 in San Diego, CA.

(U) Mr. Dayhoff joined the FBI on 12/11/1994. He has been assigned to the San Diego (SD) Division his entire career.

U (S) Mr. Dayhoff was assigned, along with Special Agent H. Mark Davis, to investigate Ramez Noaman. Noaman was identified as assisting Nawaf al-Hazmi obtain automobile insurance. Noaman had "co-signed" the policy for Nawaf al-Hazmi. Mr. Dayhoff had been advised by a citizen that al-Hazmi purchased automobile insurance from an agent of the Farmers' Group by the name of Linda Yacoub. Her husband, Saleh Yacoub was also an agent for Farmers' Group. Saleh Yacoub was a partner in two San Diego service stations with Osama Mustafa, one which was a Texaco Station on Spring Street in La Mesa, CA. Nawaf al-Hazmi briefly was employed at this service station.

U (S) Mr. Dayhoff stated that the investigation determined that the Yacoub's obtained the insurance business from the San Diego Mid-Eastern community by advertising in an Arabic language newspaper. By the time that it was determined that Noaman was a co-signer on the insurance policy, Noaman had moved to the Los Angeles area.
