1. By direction of the President, Major General Dwight D. Eisenhower 03822, AUS, is relieved from detail as a member of the General Staff Corps, from assignment to the War Department General Staff, and from assignment and duty in the Office, Chief of Staff, Washington, D.C., and is assigned to permanent station outside the continental limits of the United States, temperate climate, London, England. He will proceed on or about June 22, 1942, from Washington, D.C., and/or New York, New York, to London, England. By direction of the President, upon arrival in London, England, he will assume command of the European Theatre.

2. Travel by military, naval or commercial aircraft (Section IV, Circular 12, W.D., 1942), and by any other means of transportation, including Army transport, commercial steamship, naval vessel, belligerent vessel or aircraft, and rail is directed. TDN FD 31 P-02 A 0425-23; QN 100 P-01, 03, 07, 08 A 0500-23. A baggage allowance of seventy-seven (77) pounds while traveling by military, naval or commercial aircraft is authorized. TD by air from Washington, D.C., and/or New York, New York, to London, England, is necessary for the accomplishment of an emergency war mission. In lieu of subsistence, a flat per diem of 36.00 is authorized while traveling by military, naval or commercial aircraft, in accordance with existing law and regulations.

3. Prior to departure from Washington, D.C., General Eisenhower will have in his possession WD MD Form 81, showing inoculations and immunizations required before leaving the continental limits of the United States, and will require physical inspection as prescribed by par. 14, AR 40-100, as amended by Section III, Circular 31, W.D., 1942.

4. Attention is invited to Section II, Circular 220, W.D. 1941, regarding the preparation and distribution of extract copies.
