THE CORRECT DATE THAT WH 172 WAS IMPLEMENTED AGAINST PETE CHRISTIANSEN, WHO WAS CO-CHAIRMAN OF CORE IN THE MIAMI AREA, SHOULD BE JUNE 20, 1965, INSTEAD OF JUNE 20, 1976.

ON JUNE 20, 1965, A COPY OF THE PUBLICATION "A LIBERAL LIGHT" REFLECTING CHRISTIANSEN'S VIEWS WAS ANONYMOUSLY MAILED TO SEVEN CIVIL RIGHTS LEADERS. THE PUBLICATION WAS ACCOMPANIED BY A NOTE ALLEGING THAT CHRISTIANSEN WAS USING CORE FOR HIS OWN PERSONAL INTEREST AND THAT HE DID NOT HAVE THE TRUE INTEREST OF AMERICA AND THE BLACK FREEDOM MOVEMENT AT HEART.

ON JULY 16, 1967, ABOUT THREE WEEKS AFTER ANONYMOUS MAILINGS, IT WAS LEARNED THAT CHRISTIANSEN HAD RESIGNED HIS POSITION AS CO-CHAIRMAN OF CORE, OSTENSIVELY TO ASSUME SOME TYPE EMPLOYMENT WITH THE ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY PROGRAM.


